Subject: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017, in respect to Ghursal Limestone Mine over an extent of 8.941 hect. in Dhar District of M.P.

Sir,

Undersigned has inspected your mine in the presence of representative of lessee on 18/07/2019. Following provisions of MCDR 2017 were found violated in your mines at the time of inspection.

Rule No	Nature of violation observed in detail
	The Mining Plan of above mentioned mine was approved vide letter No. MP/Dhar/Limestone/MPLN/1008/NGP dated 14/05/2009. During the inspection deviation / violation MCDR rules observed. The extents of deviation observed during inspection are as under:

**Rule 45(5) (b)** The holder of a mining lease shall submit online returns in respect of each mine to the Regional Controller or any other authorized official of the Indian Bureau of Mines in the following manner namely: -

(b) A monthly return which shall be submitted before the tenth day of every month in respect of the preceding month in electronic form along with a signed print copy of the same if it is not digitally signed, in the prescribed form.

➤ **In this case it is found that you are not submitting monthly return online in the IBM portal.**

**Rule 45(5) (c)** The holder of a mining lease shall submit online returns in respect of each mine to the Regional Controller or any other authorized official of the Indian Bureau of Mines in the following manner namely: -(C) An annual return which shall be submitted before the 1st day of July each year for the preceding financial year in electronic form, along with a signed print copy of the same if it is not digitally signed, in the prescribed form.

➤ **In this case it is found that you are not submitting annual return online in the IBM portal.**

**Rule 55** Employment of geologists and mining engineers. (1) For the purpose of carrying out reconnaissance, prospecting or mining operations in accordance with these rules, -

- every holder of reconnaissance permit shall employ a whole-time geologist;
- every holder of prospecting licence or a prospecting license-cum-mining lease shall employ a whole-time geologist and a part-time mining engineer;
- every holder of a mining lease shall employ, in case of-
  - category 'A' mines, a whole-time mining engineer and a geologist;
  - category 'B' mines, a part-time mining engineer and a part-time geologist;


(c) **Details of mining engineer and geologist shall be provided in the prescribed form.**

It is observed that the corresponding address of the lessee has been changed from the mentioned address in approved mining plan, therefore lessee is advised to send notice of change of address in prescribed form under rule 46 (c ) of MCDR 2017 for further communication.

2. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017.
3. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 30 (Thirty) days from the date of issue of this letter.


