Five lakhs as per the provision of Rule 27(1) of MCDR, 2017 at the time of submission of final copies of the document within 15 (fifteen) days from the date of issue of this letter, failing which the document will be disposed without giving any further opportunity.

Scrutiny comments on examination of Review of Mining Plan in respect of New Jamdapur Manganese Ore mine of M/s Aditya Minerals (P) Ltd. over an extent of 93.17 Ha. located in Jamdapur Village, Adilabad Mandal & District of Telangana State submitted under Rule 17(2) of MCR, 2016.

1. Plan period be furnished as 2020-21 to 13.02.2025 (up to lease period) in cover

2. Please comment if any order issued by state government under section 4A of MMDR Act 1957 for lapsing of lease as it is stated that mining operations are not carried out since 2013.

Review of mining plan

- 3. Review of earlier 5 years block period i.e. 2015-16 to 2019-20 should only be
- 4. Justification for not carrying out exploration of 29 bore holes should be furnished.
- 5. Para 3.5, details of suspension of mining operations by the State Government for lack of EC be detailed as per the copy enclosed in Annexure I(e).

- 6. Refer table no.12; reserves assessed under category-111 is stated as 'Geological reserves', the same should be corrected as 'Proved reserves'. Similarly in table no.13 Blocked resources should have been considered under category '211' instead of '111'.
- 7. Weighted average grade of Reserves/ Resources should be furnished in table no.15.
- 8. Exploration carried out so far in the lease area under G1, G2, G3 scale be furnished in tabular form.
- 9. Refer table no.14 & 15, the total resources furnished in table no. 14 is stated as 21,696 Tonnes whereas in table no. 15 the same is furnished as 24,577 Tonnes, which is contradictory.

- 10. Excavation and production proposals for the balance period of 2020-21 should be submitted as the plan period is for the block 2020-21 to 13.02.2025 i.e. up to the
- 11. For safe and scientific mining there should maintain gap of up to 10 meters between production/ development bench and backfilling. Proposals should be suitably modified in year wise development plans. The same be depicted in plans and sections.
- 12. In year wise computation of development & production bench wise details be furnished and depicted in plans and sections.
- 13. Commitment should be made to submit the FMCP two years in advance before expiry of lease period.

14. Total area available for backfilling in the plan period is stated as 11.6 Ha, whereas area put to use for mining and allied activity is stated as 1.28 Ha only, which is contradictory

Plans and sections

15. Surface plan,

i. Details of Ground control points, Bench mark established to be detailed in the text and depicted.

ii. Surface plan should be submitted in consonance with earlier approved

document, if any change the same to be justified.

- iii. All the surface features in the lease sketch should be incorporate in plans and
- iv. Standard symbols as per MMR 1961 should be used for different features/ activities
- 16. Irrigation canal is passing through the lease area, the same be stated in the plans and sections.
- 17. Geological plan: Mineralised and Non-mineralised area, UPL to be marked distinctly. Area under G1, G2 scale etc. be shown.
- 18. Geological sections and year wise development plans and sections should be submitted in 1:500 scale for clarity to assess the ore body/ development.
- 19. Commitment be given to submit the revised lease sketch incorporating Irrigation canal passing through lease area.

Soft copies:

- 1. All plans should be furnished in soft copy "in .kml or .shp file" (KML or shape files).
- 2. Co-ordinates of lease boundary pillars should be furnished in soft copy "in .kml or .shp file" (KML or shape files).

In view of the above comments relevant para, plans and section should be suitably modified.
