Subject: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 2017 in respect of your Nanhwara Limestone Mine (2.10 Hect.) in Katni district of M.P. State.

Sir,

The following provisions of the Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 were found violated in your above mentioned mine during the inspection by Shri Abhishek Ranjan Gautam, Assistant Mining Engineer on 19.10.2022 in presence of Shri Vijay Gupta, Lessee Representative & Shri Umesh Kushwaha, Mining Engineer under detailed as below:-

Rule 11 (1)	According to this rule-No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operation in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Govt. pursuant to the provisions to clause (b) of Sub Section (2) of Section 5 or approved by the competent authority of the Atomic Minerals Directorate for exploration and Researching respect of minerals specified in Part B of the First Schedule of the Act where the grade of such atomic minerals is equal to or above the threshold value limit declared under schedule-A of the Atomic Mineral Concession Rules 2016.
	The modification of approved Mining Plan of above mentioned mine was approved vide this office letter No-MP/Katni/Limestone/RMP-70/2020-21 dated 07.07.2021 incorporating the proposals for 2021-22. During the inspection it was found that following provisions of rule have been violated.
	<ol> <li>Against proposal of 3128 M³ over burden &amp; 555 M³ top soil, there was nil achievement during the year 2021-22, lagging in development &amp; distorting the stripping ratio.</li> <li>Backfilling has not been started till date against the proposal for the year 2021-22.</li> <li>Boundary pillars no. 11 &amp; 12 are not maintained properly as per rule.</li> <li>As per annual return of 2021-22 plantations of 561 trees reported, But during</li> </ol>
	inspection no new plantation was observed.
Rule 27 (2)	MCDR 2017 has been amended vide Gazettes notification dated 03/11/2021 wherein the rate of financial assurance has been increased from Rs 3 Lakh to 5 Lakh per hectare of area put to use for mining & allied activities in case of 'A' category mines. Furnish additional Financial assurance of Rs 120400 /- (500000 already submitted) as required to

- Non-compliance of the rule 11(1) of MCDR-2017 may lead to suspension of Mining operations under the provisions of rule 11(2) of MCDR-2017.
