


Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 2017 in respect of your Barwas

Limestone Mine, Mining Lease over an area of 8.91 ha located near Village: Barwas Tehsil: Paonta Sahib,

District-Sirmour, H.P State.

The following provisions of the Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 2017 (MCDR, 2017) were found महोदय Sir, violated in your above mine during the MCDR inspection made by the undersigned on 03.11.2020 in the presence of Shri Tapender Singh, Fauji representative of lessee.

NATURE OF VIOLATION OBSERVED
The holder of a mining lease shall submit the mining plan to the competent authority for review at least on hundred and eighty days before the expiry of five years period for which it was approved on the last occasion, for mining operations for a period of five subsequent years. Modified Mining plan with PMCP was approved vide letter no. 614(2)/MP-B-193/11-DDN dated 15-03-2019 but plan with PMCP was approved vide letter no. 614(2)/MP-B-193/11-DDN dated 15-03-2019 but plan with PMCP was approved by the Review & Updation of Mining Plan with PMCP till date.
The holder of a mining lease shall, on or before the 30 <sup>th</sup> day of June every year submit to the authorized officer a digital copy along with a print copy of the surface geological plans and sections maintained under rule 32. However, the lessee has not submitted the copies of the plans and sections as per rule for the year
2019-20  Every holder of mining lease shall employ a geologist and a mining engineer in the mine. But geologist an
mining engineer have not been appointed in the line.
The holder of a mining lease has submitted incomplete or wrong information in Annual Return  1. Part-VII Cost of Production- Cost of production of Limestone is very high.

- In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of
- Mining operation can be suspended as per rule 11(2) in case of non-compliance of any Rule/sub-rule of 11 of
- Advise the State Government to order suspension of all mining operation in the mine as per provision of Rule 45(7), in case incomplete or wrong or false information has been furnished in statutory returns or fails to submit statutory returns
- You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the compliance position to this office within 45 days from date of issue of this letter.
