Table Scrutiny comments on examination of Modification of Mining Plan of Gorlagutta Limestone Block over an area of 181.03 hectares in Gorlagutta Village, Bethamcharla Mandal, Kurnool District, Andhra Pradesh submitted under Rule 17 (3) of MCR 2016.

General

1. The document shall be submitted as per the format mentioned in the FAQ on format of Mining Plans issued vide CCOM Circular 1/2021 dated 08.09.2021.
2. The final document shall adhere the conditions stipulated in CCOM circular No. 01/2021 dated 07.06.2021 & FAQ on format of Mining Plans issued vide CCOM Circular 1/2021 dated 08.09.2021.
3. The limestone requirement for the present plant capacity was submitted as 3.7 million tonnes per annum and Mining Plan of feeding mines have already been approved for 4.4 million tonnes per annum. Proper justification shall be submitted for modification in approved Mining Plan for increase in production from 0.8 million tonnes per annum to 1.2 million tonnes from this mine.

Chapter 1: General Information

1.3.6. Owner/Nominated Details

As mentioned in the Mining Plan format, minutes of Board Resolution in case of Nominated owner shall be submitted.

Copy of Id Proof of the Nominated Owner shall be submitted as annexure.

1.3.7. Qualified Person Details as per M(OAHCEM)CR, 2016

1. Copy of PAN of Qualified Person shall be submitted as Annexure.
2. Experience certificate of the Qualified Person issued by the employer where he has worked during his tenure shall be submitted.

Chapter 2: Geology & Exploration

2.2.4.13. In the earlier approved Mining Plan it was submitted that 48.06 million tones of limestone as Indicated Mineral Resources (332), whereas in the draft submission it is submitted as Probable Mineral Reserves (122). No justification given in the prefeasibility report for converting the Indicated Mineral Resources to economically mineable part.

2.2.5.5. As per rule 12(3) of MCDR 2017, the holder of mining block shall carry out detailed exploration (G1 level) over the entire potentially mineralized area under the mining lease, within a period of five years from the date of opening of the mine after execution of such mining block. Exploration proposal and commitment to complete the exploration shall be submitted accordingly.

G1 level of exploration shall be proposed and carried out for the entire mineralized area and up to discontinuance of ore body under the mining lease.

4.2.1.2. Variations found in the height of flaggy limestone dumps and light grey dumps in draft submission w.r.t approved Mining Plan.

4.2.2.2. Development and production proposal shall be submitted from 1st year onwards since cement grade limestone is available as outcrops in some areas of the mining block.

4.4. Material handled per day and per shift shall be submitted correctly in the machine calculation summary.

4.5. Explosive requirement per month in the development shall be submitted correctly in the blasting requirement chapter.

Chapter 5: Sustainable Mining

5.2. Proposal shall be submitted for CSR initiatives during the mining plan period.

5.3. Proposal shall be submitted for rehabilitation and resettlement of affected persons.

Chapter 6: Progressive Mine Closure Plan

6.1. Change in area under mining operation observed in the draft modification of mining plan submitted w.r.t the approved Mining Plan.

Chapter 7: Financial Assurance/Performance security (Area put to use)

7.2. Financial assurance plan should be submitted on the basis area put to use for mining allied activities and in view of above comments.

7.3. Performance security details shall be submitted.

Chapter 9: Progressive Mine Closure Plan
