Subject: Violation of provisions of MCDR, 2017 in respect of your Khub-I Limestone Mine (38MEG03003) over an area of 4.96 Hect. in Lumshnong Village, Taluka-Khliehriat, East Jaintia Hills district of Meghalaya State.

Sir,

The following provisions of MCDR 2017 were found violated in your above mine during the inspection carried out on 16th November 2017 by the undersigned in presence of your mine officials Shri Sikandar Prasad (Mines Agent) and Shri Hijam Rakesh Singh (Geologist).

Rule Number

11(1): No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed i) Almost 21/2 quarter of the current year by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government pursuant to the proviso to clause (b) of subsection (2) of section 5 or approved by the competent authority of the Atomic Minerals ii) It Directorate for Exploration and Research, in respect of minerals specified in Part B of the First Schedule to the Act where the grade of such atomic minerals is equal to or above the threshold value limits declared under Schedule-A of the Atomic Minerals Concession.

Nature of violations observed

The following deviations to the approved review of mining plan were found in your mine:-

- 2017-18 has been lapsed, but the configuration and pattern of existing benches are not as per proposal given in the approved development plan and section.
- has been proposed that 36628.20tons of sandstone will be generated during 2017-18. Since 21/2 quarter of the current year has been passed and as per your record generation of sandstone is nil till date.

	iii) As per condition (X) of approval letter No. IBM/GHY/MEG/EJNH/LST/MS-75, dated 29.07.2015 of the above said mine, "It is observed that the conditional order for amalgamation of the two leases has been issued by the Govt. of Meghalaya vide letter No. Mg.98/2008/23 dated 01.04.2009. It is observed that more than 6(six) years have lapsed. It is advised to pursue with the State Govt. and get the amalgamated lease deed with in a period of six months from the date of issue of this letter". Further subsequent letters have been issued by this office on dated 13.07.2016 and 08.03.2017 for submission of amalgamated lease deed to this office. In reply to the above mentioned letters, you have sought an extension of six months i.e. up-to November 2017. But till date you have not submitted the
	amalgamated lease deed to this office.

02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017.

03. The mining operations can be suspended under rule 11(2), if compliance of rule 11(1) is not found satisfactory.

04. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
