Subject: Violation of provisions of MCDR, 2017, in respect of your Wah Pynkon Limestone Mine-II (38MEG03017) over an area of 13.58 Hectares in Lumshong Village, Taluka-Khliehriat, East Jaintia Hills district of Meghalaya State.

Sir,

On perusal of the office records and violation letter of even number dated 01.10.2020 issued by Sri Vikas Kumar, ACOM, the following provision of MCDR, 2017 was found violated in your above mine.

Rule Number	Nature of violations observed
11(4): The holder of a mining lease shall submit the mining plan to the competent authority for review at least 180 days before the expiry of 5 years period for which it was approved on the last occasion, for mining operations for a period of 5 subsequent years.	<p>The existing modification of mining plan in respect of Wah Pynkon Limestone Mine-II (38MEG03017) over an area of 13.58 Hectares in Lumshong Village, Taluka- Khliehriat, East Jaintia Hills district of Meghalaya State is valid up-to 31.3.2021 and the next review was due for submission on 02.10.2020.</p> <p><i>You have submitted draft copy of review of mining plan to this office for its approval vide letter dated 14.10.2020 but the same was dis-approved for the reason recorded in writing vide this office letter dated 10.11.2020.</i></p> <p>The draft review of mining plan thereafter has not been received by this office till date.</p>


02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017.

03. The mining operations can be suspended under rule 11(2), if compliance of rule 11(1) is not found satisfactory.

04. You are therefore directed to show cause within a period of 30 (Thirty) days from the date of issue of this letter, as why you should not be prosecuted for the above offences.


