विषय /Subject: Violation of provisions of MCDR 2017 in respect of your **Karigala** Kyanite mine (ML No.2286) over an extent of 12.14 Ha having Mine code 33KAR14004, in Karigala Village, H.D. Kote Taluk, Mysuru District of Karnataka State.

Sir,

The following provisions of the Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 were found violated in your above mine during inspection on 19.10.2022 by the undersigned along with Shri Gangadhar Bhakat, Asst. Mining Engineer in the presence of Sri Shivayogi S. S, GPA Holder, Shri Bhaktavatsalam, Mining Engineer.

45(7)	<p>i) As per provision of Rule 45(5)(c) “ Annual return shall be submitted before the 1st day of July each year for the preceding financial year in electronic form”. The Annual Return for the year 2021-22 has been submitted on 6th July, 2022 which is after the due date.</p> <p>-Fine for 5 days @ ₹ 10,000/- per day from 01/07/2022 works out ₹ 50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand only)</p> <p>ii) The online Annual return for the year 2021-22 has been submitted by the Lessee; Following discrepancies are noted in the submitted copy as observed during site inspection.</p> <p>Part-I : Name of Agent, Geologist, Manager, and Mining Engineer has not been furnished.</p> <p>Part-IIA : The value of Fixed Assets has not been reported.</p>

	<p>Part-IV: The Total production during the year (in tonnes) in Part-IV (2) has not been reported correctly. The overburden removed during the year has not been reported correctly in Part-IV (3).The same has also not been furnished in Part-V: 4.2</p> <p>Part-V: a) The details of Mineral Reserves and Resources estimated at the end of the year under different UNFC codes are not reported correctly under Sec-3 as per the last approved document.</p> <p>Part-VI- a) Part-VI (1) :The figures have not been reported correctly.</p> <p>Part-VII: The correct figure may be furnished under Exploration in the table Cost of Production. There is no exploration carried out for the year 2021-22. However, the exploration cost is reported as INR. ‘20’. The cost of Production should be less than the ex-mine price for project viability in general. The same should be corrected.</p>

02. The Mining operations and dispatches may be suspended and any action under subrule (7) of Rule 45 of MCDR 2017 read with MCDR (Amendment), 2021 may be initiated.
03. In this connection, it is again brought to your notice that this violation also constitutes an offence punishable under Rule 62 of MCDR (Amendment), 2021.
04. The said penalty may be paid through <https://bharatkosh.gov.in> web portal under the purpose head “Non submission/faulty Monthly Returns, & Annual Returns in favour of “137321-Regional Controller of Mines, IBM, Bangalore” and the status of compliance to be communicated to this office immediately.
05. You are therefore, directed to show cause within a period of thirty (30) days from the date of issue of this notice, as to why action under subrule (7) of Rule 45 and Rule 62 of MCDR 2017 read with MCDR (Amendment), 2021 shall not be taken against you.
06. You are herewith given 30 days time for reply and rectification of the violation from the date of issue of this notice. The fine for the late submission of monthly return is to be made immediately as per Schedule-II of MCDR (Amendment) Rules, 2021. Please note that no further notice will be given to you in this regard.
