Subject: Violation of provisions of MCDR 2017 in respect of your Sanjeevarayanakote Iron ore Mine, ML No. 2289 over an extent of 42.42 ha having mine code 30KAR03123 in Sanjeevarayanakote Village, Bellary Taluk & District of Karnataka State.

Sir,

The following provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 were found violated in your above mine during inspection on 18.01.2023 by the undersigned in the presence of Sri Vinodh S, Mine Manager, Sri B. Nagarjuna, Geologist and others.

Rules	Nature of Violations observed
11 (1)	The Review and Updation of Mining plan was approved by IBM vide letter no. 279/584/97/BNG dated 13.11.2020, for the period from 2021-22 to 2025-26. The deviations observed in mining operation vis-à-vis approved document are given below: i) It was observed during site inspection that drilling of 5 RC boreholes with 175m meterage has been proposed during the year 2021-22. The same has not been carried out. ii) It was observed during site inspection that against the proposed Iron ore production of 89978 tonnes, the actual production is reported as 30,000 tonnes during the year 2021-22. The deviation is 67% less production.
34A	The processed output data of Satellite Image have not been submitted in accordance with the Standard Operating Procedures under sub rule (5) of rule 34A of MCDR, 2017. The following are discrepancies observed in accordance with

	<p>Standard Operating Procedure for submission of Satellite Imageries of Mining areas.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Resolution of Georeferenced Orthorectified satellite image of lease area is given as 1.606m which is greater than 1.12m as per SOP.</li><li>2. The output data submission form for satellite image i.e., Annexure-II with all details as per SOP have not been submitted in the soft copy.</li></ol>

02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of MCDR, 2017.
03. The mining operations can be suspended under rule 11(2), if compliance of rule 11(1) is not found satisfactory.
04. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office **within 45 (Forty-Five) days** from the date of issue of this letter.
