Sub: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules- 2017 (MCDR-2017) in respect of your Jamdapur Manganese Ore Mine over an extent of 78.68 Ha in Jamdapur Village, Jainath Mandal, Adilabad Dist, Telangana state.

Sir,

The following provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules 2017 (MCDR, 2017), were found violated in your above mine during inspection on 31.12.2020 by the undersigned accompanied by Sri Venkataramanaiah, Lessee's representative and K U Jenekar, QP of your Mines.

11(1)	<p><i>No holder of a mining lease shall <del>commence or</del> carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines <del>or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government pursuant to the proviso to clause (b) of sub-section (2) of section 5</del></i></p> <p>Mining operations are not being carried out in accordance with the proposals given in approved Modified Mining Plan vide letter no. AP/ADB/MP/Mn-20/Hyd dated 09.09.2019 to the extent indicated below:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>Refer page no. 24,25: It was approved to carry out exploration over 71.19 Ha area initially by 63 no. of DTH bore holes to a depth of 15 meters in 100m x 100m grid interval followed by core bore holes in mineralized area during the year 2019-20; against which No exploration has been done so far.</li><li>The mining operations are approved to carry out by mechanized means by maintaining bench height of 3.0 meters and while backfilling clear horizontal distance of 3.0 meters shall be kept from the toe of the back filled material to production face, but during inspection it was observed that bench height of about 5 meters were maintained and horizontal distance of 3.0 meters is not being maintained between production face and toe of backfilling.</li></ol>

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

During the inspection, it was observed that mining operations are being carried out within safety zone of 50 meters from 'Irrigation canal' without having no such approved proposals</p> <p>iv. It was approved to backfill the excavated pit by waste material generated, whereas during inspection of mines it was observed that waste material is dumped over mineralized area.</p> <p>v. Only 100 saplings were planted against 140 for the year 2019-20 against plantation of 140 saplings.</p> <p>vi. No area is rehabilitated for the year 2019-20 against the approved proposals of rehabilitate 1.30 Ha</p>
14(3)	<p><i>The overburden and waste material obtained during mining operations shall not be allowed to be mixed with the materials as specified in sub-rule (1).</i></p> <p>During inspection, it was observed that ore is found dumped admixed with waste material instead of stacking it separately for future use.</p>
26(2)	<p><i>The holder of mining lease shall submit to the competent authority a yearly report as per the format specified by the Indian Bureau of Mines, before 1st day of July every year setting forth the extent of protective and rehabilitative works carried out as envisaged in the approved mine closure plan, and if there is any deviation, reasons thereof:</i></p> <p>Yearly report setting forth the extent of protective and rehabilitative works carried out as envisaged in the approved mine closure plan is not submitted to RCOM, IBM Hyderabad for the years 2018-19 &amp; 2019-20</p>
31(4)	<p><i>The plans and sections required under these rules shall be maintained up to date within three months in case of category 'A' mines as referred to in clause (a) of sub-rule (2) of rule 55, and within twelve months in the case of any other mine.</i></p> <p>Plans and sections have not been found maintained updated as required under the as per the provision of this rule.</p>
43	<p><i>Permissible limits and standards.—The standards and permissible limits of all pollutants, toxins and noise referred to in rules 40, 41 and 42 shall be such as may be notified by the concerned authorities under the provisions of the relevant laws for the time being in force.</i></p> <p>To ensure the pollution due to Air, water, Noise etc. under standard permissible limits quarterly monitoring of air, water noise is to be carried out. 02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violation constitutes an offence punishable under rule 62 of MCDR, 2017. Besides inability to comply the provision of rule 11(1) is also liable for suspension of mining operations under the provision of rule 11(2) of MCDR, 2017.

03. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (forty-five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
