विषय/Subject: **Violation of provisions of MCDR 2017 in respect of your Hirabuddini Gold Mine, ML 2578 over an extent of 22.18 ha(as per lease dead) in Hirabuddini Village, Manvi Taluk , Raichur District of Karnataka State.**

Sir,

The following provisions of the Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 were found violated in your above mine during inspection on 12.01.2022 by Sri Sandeep Kumar Singh, ACOM and Shri K. Srinivas, JMG in presence of Sri Kumar Mohan Singh, Mines Manager, Sri Jhonson, Mining Engineer and other mine officials:

45(7)	<p>i) As per provision of Rule 45(5)(b) " a monthly return shall be submitted before the tenth day of every month in respect of the preceding month in electronic form". The monthly Return for the month of October, 2021 has been submitted on 11th November, 2021 which is after the due date.</p> <p>ii) The online Annual return for the year 2020-21 has been submitted by the Lessee; Following discrepancies are noted in the submitted copy as observed during site inspection.</p> <p>Part-IIA : The value of Fixed Assets has not been reported correctly.</p> <p>Part-IV: The Total production during the year (in tonnes) in Part-IV (2) has not been reported correctly. It was reported during inspection that production quantity is 25,681 tonnes. The overburden removed during the year has not been reported correctly in Part-IV (3).During the inspection, it was reported that the overburden removed is 2157 tonnes.</p> <p>Part-V: a) The details of Mineral Reserves and Resources estimated at the end of the year under different UNFC codes are not reported correctly under Sec-3 as per the last approved document.</p> <p>b) The total ROM ore production under Sec 4.2(B)(i) is applicable for opencast mine and</p>

	<p>hence the quantity "25681" tonnes reported may be removed. The tonnage of ore blocked for stopping and quantity of waste removed (tonnes) in Sec-4.3(g) & (h) have not been reported correctly.</p> <p>c) The Tailings tonnage has not been reported correctly in Sec-7(ii).</p> <p>Part-VI- a) Part-VI (1)(B):The figure reported under Total may be removed since no opencast workings are involved.</p> <p>b) The tailings quantity under Part-VI (3) and Recovery of Gold under Part-VI (4) have not been reported correctly.</p> <p>Part-VII: (a) The production proposal for financial year 2020-21 is to be corrected as "60,000" tonnes as per the approved quantity.</p> <p>(b) The correct figure may be furnished under Exploration in the table of Cost of Production. There is no exploration carried out for the year 2020-21, however the exploration cost is reported as INR. '3282.95. The same should be corrected.</p>

02. The Mining operations and dispatches may be suspended and any action under subrule (7) of Rule 45 of MCDR 2017 read with MCDR (Amendment), 2021 may be initiated.
03. In this connection, it is again brought to your notice that this violation also constitutes an offence punishable under Rule 62 of MCDR (Amendment), 2021.
- 04. You are therefore, directed to show cause within a period of thirty (30) days from the date of issue of this notice, as to why action under subrule (7) of Rule 45 and Rule 62 of MCDR 2017 read with MCDR (Amendment), 2021 shall not be taken against you.**
05. You are herewith given 30 days time for reply and rectification of the violation from the date of issue of this notice. The fine for the late submission of monthly return is to be made immediately as per Schedule-II of MCDR (Amendment) Rules, 2021. Please note that no further notice will be given to you in this regard.
