विषय/Subject: Violation of provisions of MCDR 2017 read with MCDR(Amendment),2021 in respect of your Hutti Gold Mine, ML 2671 over an extent of 528.35 ha(as per lease dead), in Hutti Village, Lingasugur Taluk, Raichur District of Karnataka State.
Sir,

The following provisions of the Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 read with Mineral Conservation and Development(Amendment) Rules, 2021 were found violated in your above mine during inspection on 13.01.2022 by the undersigned along with Shri K. Srinivas, JMG in presence of Dr. S. K. Solankar, Geologist, Sri A. Ghosh, Senior Manager Mining and other mine officials:

Rule	Nature of Violations observed
45 (7)	i)As per provision of Rule 45(5)(b) '' a monthly return shall be submitted before the tenth day of every month in respect of the preceding month in electronic form". The monthly Return for the month of Oct-2021has been submitted on 10 th November 2021 which is after the due date i.e., by 9 th of every month.
	ii)The online Annual return for the year 2020-21 has been submitted by the Lessee; Following discrepancies are noted in the submitted copy as observed during site inspection.
	Part-IIA: The value of fixed assets is not reported correctly under Part-II A (1).
	Part-IV : The Total production during the year (in tonnes) in Part-IV (2) & Overburden removed (in tonnes) in Part-IV (3) have not been reported correctly. It was reported during inspection that production quantity is

3,79,340 tonnes and total waste quantity generated is 46,348 tonnes.

Part-V: a) The Exploration meterage in Sec-4.1 have not been reported correctly. It was observed during inspection that total exploration meterage is 352 metres.

- b) The tonnage of ore blocked for stopping & Quantity of waste removed in details in Sec-4.3(g) & (h) have not been reported correctly.
- c)The Tailings tonnage have not been reported correctly in Sec-7(ii). The Metals recovered quantity to be depleted in the Tailings quantity.

<u>Part-VI-</u> a) Part-VI (1) have not been reported correctly. It was observed during site inspection that under the opening stock and closing stock of ROM the broken ore in-situ(estimated) quantity is reported whereas in production, the hoisted ore (Measured) tonnage is reported which is not relatable. The measured quantity i.e., the hoisting quantity are to be reported in all the three columns i.e., Opening, Production and closing stock.

b) The tailings quantity under Part-VI (3) have not been reported correctly.

Part-VII: The production proposal for financial year 2020-21 to be corrected as '5,23,467" tonnes as per the approved document.

- 02. The Mining operations and dispatches may be suspended and any action under subrule (7) of Rule 45 of MCDR 2017 read with MCDR (Amendment), 2021 may be initiated.
- 03. In this connection, it is again brought to your notice that this violation also constitutes an offence punishable under Rule 62 of MCDR (Amendment), 2021.
- 04. You are, therefore, directed to show cause within a period of thirty (30) days from the date of issue of this notice, as to why action under subrule (7) of Rule 45 and Rule 62 of MCDR 2017 read with MCDR (Amendment), 2021 shall not be taken against you.
- 05. You are herewith given 30 days-time for reply and rectification of the violation from the date of issue of this notice. The fine for the late submission of monthly return to be made immediately as per Schedule-II of MCDR (Amendment) Rules, 2021. Please note that no further notice will be given to you in this regard.
