विषय/Subject: **Violation of provisions of MCDR 2017 read with MCDR(Amendment),2021 in respect of your Uti Gold Mine, ML 2126 over an extent of 47.96 ha(as per lease dead), in Uti Village, Deodurga Taluk , Raichur District of Karnataka State.**

Sir,

The following provisions of the Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 read with Mineral Conservation and Development (Amendment) Rules, 2021 were found violated in your above mine during inspection on 10.01.2022 by the undersigned along with Shri K. Srinivas, JMG in presence of Sri Nagaraj, Mine Manager, Sri Ganesh, Geologist, Sri G. Shiva Krishna, Mining Engineer and other mine officials:

Rule	Nature of Violations observed
45 (7)	<p>i) As per provision of Rule 45(5)(b) " a monthly return shall be submitted before the tenth day of every month in respect of the preceding month in electronic form". The monthly Returns for the month of Oct-2021 has been submitted on 11th November 2021 which is after the due date.</p> <p>ii) The online Annual return for the year 2020-21 has been submitted by the Lessee; Following discrepancies are noted in the submitted copy as observed during site inspection.</p> <p>Part-I: The land use (area in ha) as given in Part-I (12) under 12(iv) i.e., used for waste disposal & 12(v) i.e., Occupied by plant, buildings, residential, welfare buildings & roads have not been reported correctly in accordance with approved land use pattern.</p> <p>Part-IV: The Total production during the year (in tonnes) in Part-IV (2) have not been reported correctly.</p> <p>Part-V: a) The details of Mineral Reserves and Resources estimated at the end of the year under different UNFC codes are not reported correctly under Sec-3a as per the last approved document.</p> <p>b) The total ROM ore production under Sec 4.2(B)(i) is applicable for opencast mine and hence the quantity "47329" tonnes reported may be removed. The tonnage of ore blocked</p>

	<p>for stoppin in Sec-4.3(g) have not been reported correctly.</p> <p>c) The Tailings tonnage have not been reported correctly in Sec-7(ii). The Metals recovered quantity to be depleted in the Tailings quantity.</p> <p>Part-VI- a) The ROM quantity under Part-VI (1) have not been reported correctly. "26177" tonnes reported under production from O/c working is surface ore stock handling and is not to be reported under ROM Production. The opening stock quantity and the closing stock quantity to be also mentioned depleting the dispatched quantity.</p> <p>b) The total ROM production quantity from stoping (Underground working) is not matching with the total monthly returns' quantity. The total ROM production to be corrected accordingly</p> <p>c) The tailings quantity under Part-VI (3) have not been reported correctly.</p> <p>Part-VII: a) There is no exploration carried out for the year 2020-21, however the exploration cost is reported as INR. "4003.85".</p> <p>b) Since there is error in ROM production quantity, accordingly the cost per tonne to be recalculated and overall cost of production to be corrected.</p> <p>c) The "Production proposal for financial year 2020-21" is to be corrected as "60,000" tonnes as per the approved document and the "Production reported" is also to be corrected.</p>

02. The Mining operations and dispatches may be suspended and any action under subrule (7) of Rule 45 of MCDR 2017 read with MCDR (Amendment), 2021 may be initiated.
03. In this connection, it is again brought to your notice that this violation also constitutes an offence punishable under Rule 62 of MCDR (Amendment), 2021.
04. **You are, therefore, directed to show cause within a period of thirty (30) days from the date of issue of this notice, as to why action under subrule (7) of Rule 45 and Rule 62 of MCDR 2017 read with MCDR (Amendment), 2021 shall not be taken against you.**
05. You are herewith given 30 days-time for reply and rectification of the violation from the date of issue of this notice. The fine for the late submission of monthly return to be made immediately as per Schedule-II of MCDR (Amendment) Rules, 2021. Please note that no further notice will be given to you in this regard.
