Sub: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 in respect of your Naganapur Limestone Mine (ML-2401) over an extent of 2.387 hectares situated in Naganapur Village, Mudhol Taluk, Bagalkot District, Karnataka State - Reg.

Sir,

The following provision of the Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 was found violated in your above mine during the inspection on **09/01/2019** by the undersigned.

Rule No.	Nature of Violations observed
11(1)	The mining operations in the Lease area are not carried out as per the latest approved modification in the approved mining plan. a) After approval of modification in the approved Mining Plan, the mine has stopped its production to till date. But, on the day of inspection, it was noticed that mine face movement has been done, as compared to approved plan. b) It is proposed in page-28, for restoration of safety zone, but during inspection it was noticed that no restoration has been taken place. c) It is proposed to plant 68 nos of saplings, against that no saplings have been planted. d) It is proposed in page-18, that budget has been allotted for CSR activity. But, on the day of inspection, it was noticed, no amount has been spent on CSR.
26(2)	A yearly report before 1 st July of every year setting forth the extent of protective and rehabilitation work carried out as envisaged in the approved progressive mine closure plan has not been submitted for last year 2017-2018.
35 (2)	Every holder of a mining lease shall monitor his mining and allied activities as per the notified template of star rating in the format prescribed in this behalf by the Indian Bureau of Mines from time to time, and shall submit online its self-assessment report before the 1st day of July every year for the previous financial year, along with the soft copy (in the standard format), of high resolution satellite images obtained from CARTOSAT-2 satellite LISS-IV sensor on the scale of cadastral map, as on the 31 st day of March for that financial year, covering the mining lease and an area of two kilometers from the lease boundary, to the Regional Controller or the authorized officer of the Indian Bureau of Mines. It is observed that has not submitted for the year 2017-2018. This violation was also pointed out by this office letter of even number dated 26.07.2018

45(5)(c)(i)	The annual returns are required to be submitted before 1 st July of each year for the preceding financial year. But this office has not been received the above annual returns of your mine, for the year 2017-2018.
55(1)(3) (iii)	The mine is being operated without employing the full time Mining Engineer required under the provision this rule.

02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of MCDR, 2017.
03. The mining operations can be suspended under rule 11(2) if compliance of rule 11(1) is not found satisfactory.
04. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
