विषय/Subject: Violation of provisions of MCDR 2017 in respect of your Talooru Magnesite Mine, ML 2484 of Shri. N Rajashekar over an extent of 11.88 ha, in Talooru Village, Mysuru Taluk and District of Karnataka State.

Sir,

The following provisions of the Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 were found violated in your above mine during inspection on 27.01.2021 & 28.01.2021 by undersigned and Shri. H.M Shivakumar, AME in presence of Dr. C.P. Prasanna Kumar, OP, Shri Y.Narayan Rao, Agent and other mining officials:

Nature of Violations observed
Scheme of Mining was approved by IBM vide letter no. 279/770/2003/BNG dated
1/10/2015, for five years period (2015-16 to 2019-20). The deviations observed in mining
operation vis-à-vis approved document are given below.
i) The total ROM (Magnesite ore) production proposed for the year 2019-20
is 8187 tonnes against which only 5,000 tonnes of ROM (Magnesite ore)
production has been done. The deviation in the overall Magnesite ore
production is 39 % less than the approved proposal.
ii) The total Mineral Reject quantity proposed for the year 2019-20 is 2325
Cum against which only 833 Cum of Mineral Reject is generated.
iii) The construction of 485 m retaining wall and 1175 m garland drain has
been proposed for the year 2015-16 and 380 m safety bund all along the Lease
area in 2019-20. It is observed during inspection that the retaining wall,
garland drain and safety bund construction have not been completed as per the

	iv) Two Silt Settling tank has been proposed in the year 2015-16 & 2016-17. It
	was observed during inspection that no silt settling tank construction has been
	carried out as per the proposal.
26(2)	Yearly report on PMCP setting forth the extent of protective and rehabilitative works
	carried out as per the approved Progressive mine closure plan, has not been submitted for
	the year 2019-20 as per the provision of this rule.
55	A whole time Mining Engineer has not been appointed as per the provision of this rule.
45(7)	The online Annual return for the year 2019-20 has been submitted by the Lessee;
	Following discrepancies are noted in the submitted copy as observed during site
	inspection.
	Part-I: The land use (area in ha) as given in Part-I(12) under 12(v) &(vi)are not reported
	correctly as per the latest approved document for the period 2020-21 to 2024-25.
	<u>Part-III</u> : i) The Royalty figures have not been reported correctly in Sec 2(a).
	ii) The DMF and NMET amount has not been reported correctly in Sec (5)
	(c).
	Part-V: i) The details of Mineral Reserve & Resources as given in Sec 3 are not correct as
	per the latest approved document for the period 2020-21 to 2024-25. The
	production quantity for the year 2019-20 to be depleted from the reserves and
	figures to be reported accordingly. The Resource figures will remain same.
	ii) The total quantity of ROM ore production & overburden/waste removed during
	the year 2019-20 has not been reported correctly in Sec 4.2(b) & 4.2(c)
	respectively. Also, the Quantity disposed of in external dumps 4.2(c) (ii) has also
	been not reported correctly.
	iii)The Grade of the mineral reject generated has not been reported correctly
	in Sec 4.2(B)
	Part-VI: i) The ROM ore production and Closing stock have not been reported
	correctly in Part-VI (1).
	ii) The Ex-mine price not reported correctly in Part-VI (2).

- 02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of MCDR, 2017.
- 03. The mining operations can be suspended under rule 11(2), if compliance of rule 11(1) is not found satisfactory.
- 04. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
