Subject:- Violation of provisions of MCDR, 2017 in respect of your Subbarayanahalli Iron Ore Mine (**ML No. 2629**), over an extent of **80.06 Ha(as per CEC sketch)** located in Subbarayanahalli village, Sandur Taluk, Ballari District, Karnataka State.

Sir,

The following provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 were found violated in your above mine during the inspection on **16/10/2020** by the undersigned accompanied with H M Shivakumar, AME in the presence of Sri. M.R.K Bagawan Mines Manager, Sri Sharanandan – Mining Engineer & Sri.T.Ramakrishna – Geologist and communicated to you vide this office registered letter of even number dated 05/11/2020 giving you a period of **45 (Forty Five) days** time for rectification of the same.

Rule 26(1)	<p>It was proposed in the approved document of Modifications to the Approved RUMP approved vide letter No. 279/466/95/BNG dated 04/03/2019 for the two years period 2018-19 to 2019-20. The deviations observed in mining operations vis-a-vis approved document are given below:</p> <p>Against the proposed construction of 236 mtrs of Retaining wall during the year 2019- 20 only 110 mtrs of Retaining wall is constructed thus deviating from carrying out the protective measures including reclamation and rehabilitation works that have to be carried out in accordance with the approved mine closure plan</p>

02. Till date you have not complied the pointed out violation and the reply received from you vide your letter dated 10/12/2020 has been examined and is not found satisfactory in respect of the rules violated.

03. It is again brought to your notice that these violations constitute an offence punishable under rule 62 of MCDR 2017. On non compliance of the above provisions of MCDR 2017, the mining operation can be suspended under the rule 11(2) of the above mentioned rules.

04. You are therefore, directed to **show cause** within a period of **30 (thirty) days** from the date of issue of this letter as to why you should not be prosecuted for the above offence.

05. Please note that no further notice will be given to you in this regard.
