Subject: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017, in respect to Hinauti Extension Limestone Mine over an extent of 258.867 hect. in Sidhi District of M.P.

Sir,
Undersigned has inspected your mine in the presence of Mines officials and QP Shri R Purohit on 30/05/2019. Following provisions of MCDR 2017 were found violated in your mines at the time of inspection.

Rule No	Nature of violation observed in detail

Rule 11(1) No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government.

The Modification in approved Mining Plan of above mentioned mine was approved vide letter No. 314(3)/2007 MCCM (CZ)/MP/10 dated 24/05/2007b (fresh grant) (Lease execution date 11.01.2017). During the inspection it was observed that mining operations in the mine was not carried out in accordance with the proposals given in the approved Review of Mining Plan. The extents of deviation observed during inspection are as under:

- In approved Mining Plan it was proposed to drill 18 nos of core boreholes in first three years. During the inspection it was observed that above mentioned proposal was not completed till the date of inspection which is 30/05/2019.

- In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017.
- The mining operations can be suspended under the rule 11(2) of MCDR-2017, if compliance of rule 11(1) of MCDR-2017 is not found satisfactory.
- You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
