विषय - मध्य प्रदेश राज्य के Chhattarpur जिले में स्थित आपकी Khera-Majjora Iron Ore Mine (क्षेत्रफल. 4.60 हे०) में खनिज संरक्षण एवं विकास नियमावली, 2017 के नियमों का उल्लंघन। (Mine Code-30MPR07701)
महोदय,

The following provisions of the Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 were found violated in your above mine during inspection on 09/12/19 by Shri Sanjay M. Girhe, Regional Mining Geologist.
The violations were communicated to you vide this office registered AD letter of even no. dated 21/01/2020 giving you a time period of 45 (forty five) days for rectification of the same.

Rule.	Nature of violations observed .
11(1) of MCDR 2017	<i>No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operation in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Govt.</i> The Mining Plan of above mentioned mine was approved vide this office letter No-MP/Chhattarpur/Iron Ore/MPLN-02/12-13 dated 13/02/2013 incorporating the proposals of working from 2015-16 to 2019-20 w.e.f. mining lease execution. During the inspection it was found that following provisions of rule have been violated 1) In the approved Mining Plan, it was proposed to drill 04 numbers of core boreholes during ensuing 5 year plan period. But, it observed that, lessee has not carried out the exploration as per the proposals till the date of inspection which deviations in accordance with approved proposals.
35(2) of MCDR 2017	<i>Every holder of a mining lease shall monitor his mining & allied activities as per the notified template of Star rating in the format prescribed in this behalf by Indian Bureau of Mines from time to time , and shall submit online its self assessment report before the first day of July every year for the previous financial year, along with the soft copy of high resolution satellite images from CARTOSAT-2 satellite LISS-IV sensor on the scale of cadastral map under provision of rule”.</i> But, it is found that, you have not submitted the Star Ratings Templates for the year 2018-19 in online system under the stipulated time as required under this rule. Hence, it is violation of aforesaid mentioned rule and further non-compliance of this rule may lead to the suspension of mining operations where at least three star rating has not been achieved within a period of four years with effect from the 27 th February, 2017 or four years from the date of commencement of mining operations, as the case may be.
45(5)(C) of MCDR 2017	<i>The holder of a mining lease shall submit online returns in respect of each mine to the Regional Controller of Mine or any other authorized officer of the Indian Bureau of Mines in the following manner-</i> An annual Return which shall be submitted before 1st day of July each year for the preceding financial year in electronic form, along with signed print copy of the same if it is digitally signed, in the respective Form But, it is observed that, you have not submitted online Annual Return for the year 2018-19 till the date of inspection to this Regional office. It is also directed to submit aforesaid returns in online system immediately through www. ibm . gov . in / index. Php /auth/login .

If it is found that the holder of a mining lease or the person or company engaged in trading storage or end-use or export of minerals, as the case may be, has submitted incomplete or wrong or false information in daily or monthly or annual returns or fails to submit a return within the date specified

As per this office records & offline annual returns submitted by you for the year 2018-19, it was observed that closing stocks at mine head of some of the Iron ore grades like 55% to Below 58% (Lumps)-6290.36M.T., 58% to Below 60% (Lumps)-15439.98M.T., 60% to Below 62% (Lumps)-17126.06M.T, etc. as reported in said annual return not found available at mine site at the time of inspection.

02. Your reply vide letter no. 1189/JMPL/2020 dated 12/12/2020 has been duly considered and violation of rule 35(2) of MCDR, 2017 is considered as complied. Justification for rest of the violations 11(1),45 (5)(c) & 45(7)of MCDR, 2017 not found satisfactory and these violations are still outstanding.
03. In this connection it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under rule 62 of MCDR, 2017
04. Non compliance of the rule 11(1) of MCDR-2017 may lead to suspension of mining operations under rule 11(2) of MCDR-2017 & further for the non-compliance of Rule 45(5)(C) of MCDR,2017, necessary action shall be initiated as deemed fit under the provision of rule 45(7) of MCDR,2017 .
05. You are, therefore, directed to show cause within a period of **30 (thirty) days** from the date of Issue of this letter, as to why you should not be prosecuted for the above offences.
06. Please note that no further notice will be given to you in this regard.
