**Sub: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 2017 in respect of Narma Bauxite Mine, over an extent of 21.00 Hectares situated in Narma Village, Gumla District, Jharkhand State - Reg.**

Sir,

Undersigned inspected your above mine on **25.10.2021** along with Shri. B.L. Kisku, AME, IBM, Ranchi in presence of the mine officials Shri. P.K.Sen (Qualified Person) and this office Violation letter number BIH/GML/Bx/243/RRO dated 14/12/2021 was issued under Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 2017.

Rule No.	Nature of Violations observed
11(1)	The mining operations in the Lease area are not carried out as per the last approved Review of mining plan. a) There is no proposal to extend the Quarry-8 during the approved plan period, but during inspection it was noticed that, Quarry-8 has been extended towards the Boundary Pillar-18 of 7.5m safety barrier. b) It is proposed to work in Quarry-1 during the approved plan period, against that no working has been carried out that in Quarry-1, whereas 42000 tons of bauxite has been produced during 2017-2018 & 2018-2019. c) During inspection it has noticed that few Quarry are worked and waste heaps are stacked within un-proposed area, in between Quarry-3 & 4. d) There is no proposal to re-handle the dump during the approved plan period, against that Dump-1 & 2 has been removed and 10680 tons of waste generated during 2017-2018 & 2018-2019 is not available in the lease area. e) It is proposed in Page-48 to backfill around 0.68 hectares upto 2020-2021, against that no area has been backfilled in the lease area.
11(4)	The Review of Mining Plan has not been submitted for approval at least one hundred and eighty days before the expiry of the five years period for which it was approved on the last occasion, for mining operations for a period of five subsequent year. <b>(Approved Review of Mining Plan, No.:- RAN/GML/BX/MP- 01/2016-17 dated 05.09.2016 was valid up to 31.03.2021)</b>

1. Your reply vide letter No. Nil dated 28/01/2022 received in this office has been examined and reply given for compliance of Rule 26(2) of MCDR 2017 is found satisfactory. However, it has been found that even after lapse of **45 (Forty Five) days** from the issue of violation letter, the violations for the **Rule 11(1) & 11(4) of MCDR-2017, remain to be continued.** Hence the following violation stands.
2. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violation constitutes an offence, punishable under **Rule 62** of MCDR, 2017.
3. The Mining operations can be suspended under **Rule 11(2)**, if compliance of Rule 11(1) is not found satisfactory.
4. You are therefore, directed to show cause within a period of **30 (Thirty) days** as to why you should not be prosecuted for the above offence and/or why mining operations shall not be suspended as per provision of MCDR, 2017.
5. Please note that no further notice will be given to you in this regard.
