Subject: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017, in respect to
Badari Limestone Mine over an area of 1.121 hect. in Katni District of M.P.


Sir,

The following provisions of the Mineral Conservation and Development Rules 2017 were found violated in your above mine during the inspection in connection with submitted draft RMP on 17.01.2022 by Sh. Jay Kumar Pandey, Assistant Mining Engineer, accompanied by Sh. Mukesh Prasad, Mines Manager & Shri Sushil Bajpai, QP.

नियम स.	पाए गए उल्लंघन की विस्तृत प्रकृति
Rule 11(1)	No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government pursuant to the proviso to clause (b) of sub-section (2) of section 5 or approved by the competent authority of the Atomic Minerals Directorate for Exploration and Research, in respect of minerals specified in Part B of the First Schedule to the Act where the grade of such atomic minerals is equal to or above the threshold value limits declared under Schedule-A of the Atomic Minerals Concession Rules, 2016. The document of above mentioned mine was approved vide letter No.- MP/Katni/Limestone /MOD-54/2017-18 dated 08/08/2017 incorporating proposal of working from 2017-18 to 2021-22. (a) In the year 2020-21, against targeted 28750 tonnes of limestone production only 8935 tonnes of limestone production reported in AR.
Rule 26(2)	The holder of mining lease shall submit to the competent authority a yearly report as per the format specified by the Indian Bureau of Mines, before 1 st day of July every year setting forth the extent of protective and rehabilitative works carried out as envisaged in the approved mine closure plan, and if there is any deviation, reasons thereof. Lessee has not submitted annual PMCP report for the reporting year (2020-21).
Rule 46	The notice of appointment for Mining Engineer & Part time geologist sent to this office without their educational qualification and working experience certificate hence copy of appointment notice alongwith educational qualification and working experience certificate needs to be submitted.

- In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservations and Development Rules, 2017.
- The mining operations can be suspended under the rule 11(2) of MCDR-2017, if compliance of rule 11(1) of MCDR-2017 is not found satisfactory.
- You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty-Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
