Sub: Violation of provisions of MCDR, 2017 in respect of your Manoharpur Iron Ore Mine (Dhobil Lease) over an area of 513.036 hect., Singhbhum (West) district, Jharkhand state.

Sir,

The following provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 (MCDR, 2017) were found violated in the above mine during inspection on 09/11/2018 by the undersigned in presence of Shri Rajesh Kumar, Mining Engineer.

Rule No.

Nature of Violation

Rule 35(2):- Every holder of a mining lease shall submit the soft copy (in the standard format) of high resolution satellite images obtained from CARTOSAT-2 satellite LISS-IV sensor on the scale of cadastral map, as on the 31st day of March'2018 for financial year 2017-18, covering the mining lease and an area of two kilometers from the lease boundary, to the Regional Controller or the authorized officer of the Indian Bureau of Mines.

But, it was observed that no such map in soft copy has been received by the Regional Controller or the authorized officer of the Indian Bureau of Mines.

02. In this connection it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under rule 62 of MCDR, 2017. The relevant extract of the rule 62 is given below.

“62 Penalty: - Whoever contravenes any of the provisions of these rules shall be punishable with imprisonment for a term which may extend to two years, or with fine which may extend to Five lakh rupees or with both, and in the case of continuing contravention with an additional fine which may extend up to Fifty thousand rupees for every day during which such contravention continues, after conviction for the first such contravention”.

03. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office, within 45 (forty five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
