The following provisions of the Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 were found violated in your above mine during inspection on 09.03.2021 by undersigned in presence of Shri R. Nirmal Kumar, Mine Manager, Shri R. Chandrashekar, Geologist and other mining officials:

reported correctly as per the last approved document.
Part-V: i) The details of Mineral Reserve & Resources as given in Sec 3 are not correct as
per the last approved document. The production quantity for the year 2018-19 &
2019-20 to be depleted from the reserves and figures to be reported accordingly.
The Resource figures will remain same.
ii) The details of no of benches, Average height & Depth of the deepest
working from adjacent ground are not reported correctly in section 4.2(open
cast).
iii) The machineries details like tipper capacity and the drill machine details have
not been reported correctly in Sec (5).

- 02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of MCDR, 2017.
- 03. The mining operations can be suspended under rule 11(2), if compliance of rule 11(1) is not found satisfactory.
- 04. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
