It is brought out to your kind notice that, Mineral Conservation & Development (Amendment) Rules, 2021 was notified vide G.S.R. no 780 (E) dated 3/11/2021 and as per Schedule II of said Rules, in case of violation under Rule 45, the lessee shall pay Rs. 10,000/- per day after due date of submission of return till rectification of violation.
