CIRCULAR

Subject: Canvassing of political or other outside influence by the employees of IBM.

It has come to notice that a few employees of IBM are bringing political or other outside influence to bear upon the senior authorities to further their interest pertaining to service matters. It has also been observed that the relatives of some employees make representations concerning service matters affecting the Government employees. In this matter it is to reiterate that such activities by the Government employees are not in order as per the Rule 20 of CCS (Conduct) Rules 1964. Even in one such instance the matter has been viewed very seriously by Ministry of Mines.

All officers and staff of IBM are, therefore, requested to advise such employees, who bring political or other outside influence on the superior authorities, to desist from such practices, which are against the provisions of CCS (Conduct) Rules, 1964.

If any employee of IBM is found violating the provisions of CCS (Conduct) Rules, 1964, disciplinary action will be initiated against such employees under the provisions of CCS (CCA) Rules, 1965.
