Subject: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017, in respect to your Tiloura Limestone Mine, 38MPR35113, 193.252 hectare, in Village of Tiloura, Tehsil-Maihar, District Satna of Madhya Pradesh.

Following provisions of MCDR 2017 were found violated in your above mine during the inspection by the Undersigned on **23.12.2020** in the presence of Shri Sourabh Kumar Jain (General Manager Geology), Shri D.K.Sharma (Mines Manager) and Shri Akhilesh Rai.

| 26(2) | <p>The holder of mining lease shall submit to the competent authority a yearly report as per the format specified by the Indian Bureau of Mines, before 1st day of July every year setting forth the extent of protective and rehabilitative works carried out as envisaged in the approved mine closure plan, and if there is any deviation, reasons thereof:</p> <p>During scrutiny of the office records, it has been observed that the yearly report on PMCP setting forth the extent of protective and rehabilitative works carried out as per the approved Progressive Mine Closure Plan for the year 2019-20 has not been submitted till date</p> |

1. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017.
2. The mining operations can be suspended under the rule 11(2) of MCDR-2017, if compliance of rule 11(1) of MCDR-2017 is not found satisfactory.
3. You are advised to rectify the violations of abovementioned rules immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty-Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
