The following provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules'2017 were found violated in your above said mine during inspection on **26.11.2018** by the undersigned in the presence of Mr. K. Venu, your representative and Mr. B.A. Patil, TQP and violation letter of even no., dtd. **06.12.2018** was issued for below mentioned rules of MCDR.2017.

- **02.** You were advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (forty-five) days from the date of issue of aforesaid letter. However, no response has been received so far from your side in respect of compliance of above violations.
- **03.** In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of MCDR, 2017.
- **04.** Action according to Rule 45(7) of MCDR, 2017 can be initiated, if compliance of Rule 45 is not found satisfactory.
- **05.** You are therefore directed to show cause within a period of **30 (thirty) days** from the date of issue of this letter as to why you should not be prosecuted for the above offence and/or the mining operations should not be recommended for suspension in accordance to Rule 45(7) of MCDR, 2017.
- **06.** Please note that no further notice will be given to you in this regard.
