Sub: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 (MCDR,2017) in respect of your Hebbal Limestone & Dolomite Mine, (ML No. 2493), over an extent of 4.86 Ha. Situated in Tk- Mudhol, Bagalkot Dist., Karnataka.

Sir,

The following provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules'2017 were found violated in your above said mine during inspection on 10.12.2020 by the undersigned in the presence of Shri. Prakash Sabarad, Lessee's Representative, Shri M. Bhima Reddy, Mines Manager and other officials of your mine.

| 11 (1) | Mining operations have not been carried out in accordance with the Modification of Mining Plan (MMP) approved dtd:- 13.12.2017 to the extent indicated below:- (i) Protection measures i.e. Retaining/toe wall, garland drains etc. (ref- Reclamation Plan) proposed to constructed around the waste Dump (near BP-3) have not been constructed so far. (ii) In MMP, it has been proposed to appoint mining engineer and geologist as per statutory requirement. Moreover, as per Rule 55 (1) (c) of MCDR'2017, every holder of mining lease has to employ a mining engineer and a geologist. However, mining engineer and geologist have not been employed in the mine. |
| 35 (2) | Every holder of a mining lease shall monitor his mining and allied activities as per notified template of star rating in the format prescribed in this behalf by the Indian Bureau of Mines and shall submit online its self-assessment report before the 1st day of July each year for the previous financial year, along with the soft copy of high resolution satellite image as on 31 st March for that financial year covering the mining lease and area of two km from the lease boundary, to the Regional controller of IBM. However, It is observed that the same has not been submitted for your aforesaid mining lease for the year 2019-20 so far. |
| 45 (5) (b) | A monthly Return ought to be submitted before the tenth day of every month in respect of the preceding month. However, monthly Returns for the month of Nov.,2020 observed to be not submitted till date. |

| 45 (5) (c) | An Annual Return ought to be submitted before the 1 st day of July each year for the preceding financial year. However, Annual Return for the year 2019-20 found to be submitted in August'2020, i.e. not within the stipulated time-frame. |
| 45 (7) | (i) Registration no. as allotted by the Indian Bureau of Mines to the buyers in respect of Sales/dispatch effected from the Mine has not been mentioned for all the buyers in the Annual Return submitted for year 2019-20, i.e. Registration no. of consignees BHARAT LIME INDUSTRIES, NAVEEN INDUSTRIES, SHREE GANESH MINERALS & INDUST, SHIVSHANTI MINERALS, & SHREYAS INDUSTRIES were not mentioned. (ii) Registration no. as allotted by the Indian Bureau of Mines to the buyers in respect of Sales/dispatch effected from the Mine has not been mentioned for all the buyers in the Monthly Return of Oct.'2020, i.e. Registration no. of consignee GANGA MINERALS PULVERIZER UNIT & TABSONS INDUSTRIES were not mentioned. Same discrepancies are also observed in other monthly returns submitted. |

- 02.** In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of MCDR, 2017.
- 03.** *The mining operations can be suspended under Rule 11 (2) /& 45(7), if compliance of Rule 11 (1) /& 45 is not found satisfactory.*
- 04.** You are advised to rectify the above violations **immediately** and intimate the position to this office **within 45 (forty-five) days** from the date of issue of this letter.
