Subject: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 2017 in respect of your Jaypee Limestone Mine (200.554 Hect.) Mine code 38MPR33006 in Rewa district of M.P. State.

Sir,

The following provisions of the Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 were found violated in your above mentioned mine during inspection on 08/03/2022 by the undersigned in presence of Shri Dinkar Dashora, AVP Mines.

Rule 11 (1)	<p>According to this rule-No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operation in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of.</p> <p>The Review of Mining Plan of above mentioned mine was approved vide this office letter No- MP/REWA/LIMESTONE/RMP-37/2018-19 dated 03.01.2019 incorporating the proposals of working from 2019-20 to 2023-24. During the inspection it was found that following provisions of rule have been violated</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Bench parameters are not maintained as per proposal, as high wall is created. 2. It was proposed to produce 250000 metric tons of Limestone in the year 2020-21 but only 123713 tons production achieved, as reported in Annual return.
Rule 26(2)	<p>The holder of mining lease shall submit a yearly report as per the format specified before 1st July of every year setting forth the extent of protective and rehabilitative work carried out as envisaged in the approved mine closure plan, and if there is any deviation, reason thereof</p> <p>Annual PMCP report not submitted for the reporting year (2020-21).</p>



Rule 45(7)	<p>If it is found that the holder of a mining lease or the person or company engaged in trading or storage or end-use or export of minerals, as the case may be, has submitted incomplete or wrong or false information in daily or monthly or annual returns or fails to submit a return within the date specified; then,-</p> <p>in the case of mining of minerals by the holder of a mining lease, the Regional Controller of Mines may,-</p> <p>order suspension of all mining operations in the mine and to revoke the order of suspension only after ensuring proper compliance;</p> <p>take action to initiate prosecution under these rules;</p> <p>recommend termination of the mining lease, in case such suppression or misrepresentation of information indicates abetment or connivance of illegal mining;</p> <p>On examination of Annual Return for the year 2020-21 it is observed that data of annual return are incomplete & having following deficiencies:-</p> <p>Depreciation component of Production cost should be made based on actual machinery deployed.</p>
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02. In this connection it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of MCDR-2017.
03. Non-compliance of the rule 11(1) & of MCDR-2017 may lead to suspension of Mining operations under the provisions of rule 11(2) of MCDR-2017.
04. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty-Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.




