SUB: Modified Violation of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017,(MCDR'17) in respect of your Ambliyara Bauxite Mines(Lease Area: 2.00 Ha) near Village Ambliyara of District: Aravalli in Gujarat.

Sir,

The following provisions of MCDR, 2017 were found violated in your above mine during inspection on 22/11/2018 by undersigned in presence of Shri Malhar Pandaya, Shri Bilal Faruk Memon Partners/Owner representative and Shri Deepak Gaur, Qualified Person

13(1)	<p>Mining operation have not been carried out in accordance with the approved Mining Scheme , approved vide letter No. 682(23)/MS-550/2009, Dated 12.11.2014 to the extent that ,It was proposed in chapter-4 of approved scheme of mining that during the year 2017-18, four number of trench pits i.e PT-1,PT-2 & PT-3 will be dug to explore the lease area. 45(5)(b)	<p>The holder of a mining lease shall submit online returns in respect of each mine to the Regional Controller or any other authorized official of the Indian Bureau of Mines in the following manner a monthly return which shall be submitted before the 10th day of every month in respect of the preceding month in electronic form along with a signed print copy of the same if it is not digitally signed, in the prescribed form. You have not submitted the monthly returns from April 2017 to till date</p>												

45(5)(e)	The holder of a mining lease shall submit online returns in respect of each mine to the Regional Controller or any other authorized official of the Indian Bureau of Mines in the following manner an annual return which shall be submitted before the 1st day of July each year for the preceding financial year in electronic form along with a signed print copy of the same if it is not digitally signed, in the prescribed form You have not submitted the annual returns from the year 2015-16 to 2017-18

02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under rule 62 of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017.

03. The mining operations can be suspended under rule 11 (2)/35(4) of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017, further under Rule 45(7)(a) of MCDR 2017, this office may advise the State Government to-

- (i) Order suspension of all mining operations in the mine and to revoke the order of suspension only after ensuring proper compliance;
- (ii) Take action to initiate prosecution under these rules;
- (iii) Recommend termination of the mining lease, in case such suppression or misrepresentation of information indicates abetment or connivance of illegal mining;

04. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (forty-five) days from the date of issue of this letter.

Hence opinion of State environment protection authority of Gujarat may also be sought for continuation of such mining with valid environment clearance.
