
The following provisions of MCDR, 2017 were found violated in your above mine during inspection on 22/11/2018 by undersigned in presence of Shri Jayeshbhai Muljibhai Patel, Shri Gobind Bhai Patel, Owner Representative and Shri Deepak Gaur, Qualified Person.

35(2)	Every holder of a mining lease shall monitor his mining & allied activities as per the notified template of star rating in the format prescribed in this behalf by Indian Bureau of Mines from time to time, and shall submit online its self-assessment report before the first day of July every year for the previous financial year, along with the soft copy of high resolution satellite images from CARTOSAT-2 satellite LISS-IV sensor on the scale of cadastral map under provision of rule. You have not submitted the templates for 2017-18 in online system.												
45(5)(b)	The holder of a mining lease shall submit online returns in respect of each mine to the Regional Controller or any other authorized official of the Indian Bureau of Mines in the following manner a monthly return which shall be submitted												

	before the 10th day of every month in respect of the preceding month in electronic form along with a signed print copy of the same if it is not digitally signed, in the prescribed form. You have not submitted the monthly returns from April 2017 to till date
45(5)(c)	The holder of a mining lease shall submit online returns in respect of each mine to the Regional Controller or any other authorized official of the Indian Bureau of Mines in the following manner an annual return which shall be submitted before the 1st day of July each year for the preceding financial year in electronic form along with a signed print copy of the same if it is not digitally signed, in the prescribed form You have not submitted the annual returns from the year 2015-16 to 2017-18

02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under rule 62 of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017.
03. The mining operations can be suspended under rule 11 (2)/35(4) of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017, further under Rule 45(7)(a) of MCDR 2017, this office may advise the State Government to-
- (i) Order suspension of all mining operations in the mine and to revoke the order of suspension only after ensuring proper compliance;
  - (ii) Take action to initiate prosecution under these rules;
  - (iii) Recommend termination of the mining lease, in case such suppression or misrepresentation of information indicates abetment or connivance of illegal mining;
04. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (forty-five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
