Subject: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017, in respect of Aber Limestone Mines, over an area of 17.408 hectares, Mine code 38MPR35284 at Village Aber, Tehsil-Rampur Baghelan and District (M.P.)

Sir,

Following provisions of MCDR 2017 were found violated in your above mine during the inspection by the Undersigned on **01.10.2020** in the presence of Shri Sudhanshu Tomar (Lessee's Representative).

Rule No	Nature of violation observed in detail
26(2)	<p>The holder of mining lease shall submit to the competent authority a yearly report as per the format specified by the Indian Bureau of Mines, before 1st day of July every year setting forth the extent of protective and rehabilitative works carried out as envisaged in the approved mine closure plan, and if there is any deviation, reasons thereof:</p> <p>During scrutiny of the office records, it has been observed that the yearly report on PMCP setting forth the extent of protective and rehabilitative works carried out as per the approved Progressive Mine Closure Plan for the year 2019-20 has not been submitted till date.</p>
45(5)(c)	<p>The holder of a mining lease shall submit online returns in respect of each mine to the Regional Controller or any other authorized official of the Indian Bureau of Mines in the following manner namely: -</p> <p>(c) an annual return which shall be submitted before the 1st day of July each year for the preceding financial year in electronic form, along with a signed print copy of the same if it is not digitally signed, in the respective Form.</p> <p>The Annual Return for the year 2019-20 has not been submitted.</p>

55(1)(c)(i)	For the purpose of carrying out reconnaissance, prospecting or mining operations in accordance with these rules, – (c) every holder of a mining lease shall employ, in case of category 'A' mines, a whole-time mining engineer and a geologist; It has been observed that whole time Mining Engineer and Geologist have not been appointed for this lease area as per provisions of rule.
