Subject: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017, in respect to Badari Limestone Mine (1.121 Ha), M/s. ACC Limited, Mine code 38MPR18074 at Village-Badari, Taluk.- Vijayraghavgarh, District- Katni (M.P.)- 483501.

Sir,

Following provisions of MCDR 2017 were found violated in your above mine during the inspection by the Undersigned on 07/10/2020 in the presence of Shri Manish Upadhyay (Deputy General Manager), Shri Mukesh Prasad (Chief Manager Mines), Shri Sanjeev Sharma (Chief Manager Geology).

Rule No	Nature of violation observed in detail
11(1)	<p>The modification in the approved Mining Plan for the above mentioned mine vide letter No. MP/Katni/Lst/MPLN/Mod-54/2017-18, dated 08/08/2017 for the period 2017-18 to 2021-22.</p> <p>As per the approved plan there was no proposal for overburden removal for the year 2019-20 but during inspection it was observed that 4761 m³ of overburden removal was carried out. This amounts to deviation from the approved proposals.</p>
26(2)	<p>The holder of mining lease shall submit to the competent authority a yearly report as per the format specified by the Indian Bureau of Mines, before 1st day of July every year setting forth the extent of protective and rehabilitative works carried out as envisaged in the approved mine closure plan, and if there is any deviation, reasons thereof:</p> <p>During scrutiny of the office records, it has been observed that the yearly report on PMCP setting forth the extent of protective and rehabilitative works carried out as per the approved Progressive Mine Closure Plan for the year 2019-20 has not been submitted till date.</p>
33	<p>The holder of mining lease shall on or before the 30th day of the June every year submit to the authorized officer, as the case may be, and the State Govt. a digital copy along with a print copy of the surface geological plans and sections maintained under rule 32. As per records plans and sections have not been submitted by lessee at this office till date.</p>
35 (2)	<p>High resolution satellite images obtained from CARTOSAT-2 satellite LISS-IV sensor on the scale of cadastral map, as on 31st March for that financial year, covering the mining lease and an area of 2 kilometres from the lease boundary was not submitted to the Regional Controller of Mines, IBM-Jabalpur.</p>

1. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservations and Development Rules, 2017.
2. The mining operations can be suspended under the rule 11(2) of MCDR-2017, if compliance of rule 11(1) of MCDR-2017 is not found satisfactory.
3. You are advised to rectify the violations of abovementioned rules immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty-Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
