Subject: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017, in respect to Jamwanikala Limestone Mine (8.01 Ha), M/s. ACC Limited, Mine code 38MPR18075 at Jamuwani Kalan, Taluk.- Vijayraghavgarh, District- Katni (M.P.)- 483501.

Sir,

Following provisions of MCDR 2017 were found violated in your above mine during the inspection by the Undersigned on 03/09/2020 in the presence of Shri N.Santhosh Kumar (Mines Manager).

Rule No	Nature of violation observed in detail
11(1)	<p>The modification in the approved Mining Plan for the above mentioned mine vide letter No. MP/Katni/Lst/MPLN/Mod-79/2017-18, dated 10/04/2018 for the period 2018-19 to 2022-23. The deviation in proposal observed vis-à-vis approved document is given below:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ During inspection it was observed that the development towards the southern side is lagging behind the approved proposals for the year 2019-20.➤ In the year 2019-20 there was proposal for topsoil generation of 5076 m³ but only 3210 m³ achieved.➤ In the year 2019-20 there was proposal for overburden generation of 1773 m³ but only 1108.67 m³ achieved.➤ In the year 2019-20 the total Quantity of ROM mineral production proposed is 39893 MT but only 24670 MT achieved.
33	<p>The holder of mining lease shall on or before the 30th day of the June every year submit to the authorized officer, as the case may be, and the State Govt. a digital copy along with a print copy of the surface geological plans and sections maintained under rule 32. As per records plans and sections have not been submitted by lessee at this office till date.</p>

35 (2)	High resolution satellite images obtained from CARTOSAT-2 satellite LISS-IV sensor on the scale of cadastral map, as on 31st March for that financial year, covering the mining lease and an area of 2 kilometres from the lease boundary was not submitted to the Regional Controller of Mines, IBM-Jabalpur.
45(7)	Following deficiency was observed in the Annual Returns submitted for the year 2019-20. Part-V (Item No-4.2): 1.Total quantity of OB wastes removed / disposed during the year is not mentioned whereas it is mentioned in the online self-assessment report of star rating submitted by the lessee. 2. Quantity disposed of in external dumps is not mentioned. 3. Also, cumulative figure should be checked and corrected.

1. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservations and Development Rules, 2017.
2. The mining operations can be suspended under the rule 11(2) of MCDR-2017, if compliance of rule 11(1) of MCDR-2017 is not found satisfactory.
3. You are advised to rectify the violations of abovementioned rules immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
