Subject: Violation of provisions of MCDR, 1988 in respect of your Tiragandladinne and Mopadu Quartz mine over an extent of 44.117 ha in Tiragandladinne and Mopadu villages, Pamuru mandal, Prakasam dist Andhra Pradesh

Sir,

The following provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules 1988 (Amended) up to 2011, were found violated in your above mine during inspection on 07-05.2013 by Sri S.Ranganath, Assistant Mining Geologist of this office. He was accompanied by Sri Ashok as your representative.

Rule No.	Nature of Violation
12(3)	<p>The scheme of mining shall be submitted to the Regional Controller [or the officer authorised in this behalf by the State Government, as the case may be,] at least one hundred twenty days before the expiry of the five years period, for which it was approved on the last occasion.</p> <p>It has been observed that the lease was executed on 01.08.2002 and the proposals of approved Mining Plan were valid up to 31.3.2007, but no Scheme of Mining for next five years has been submitted to the competent authority of Directorate of Mines & Geology, Govt. of Andhra Pradesh so far as per rule.</p>
13(1)	<p>Every holder of a mining lease shall carry out mining operations in accordance with the approved mining plan with such conditions as may have been prescribed under sub-rule (2) of rule 9 or with such modifications, if any, as permitted under rule 10 or the mining plan or scheme approved under rule 11 or 12 as the case may be.</p> <p>The Mining Operations should be undertaken in accordance with the approved Mining Plan/Scheme of Mining. Since you have no approved Scheme of Mining for your above referred mine, it is evident that the mining operations are not being carried out in accordance with the approved Scheme of Mining.</p>
45(1)&(2)	<p>The owner, agent, mining engineer or mine manager of every mine or any person or company engaged in trading or storage or end use or export of minerals mined in the country, shall cause himself to be registered with the Indian Bureau of Mines as per application specified in Form-M and the registration number so allotted by Indian Bureau of Mines shall be used for all purposes of reporting and correspondence connected with but no such application for registration was made with Indian Bureau of Mines so far, as required under this rule. "The registration is to be undertaken by the lessee 'online' through the websites www.ibmreg.nic.in or www.ibm.nic.in.</p>
45(5)(a)(viii) & 45(5)(b)(viii)	<p>The owner, agent, mining engineer or manager of every mine, shall submit to the Regional Controller of Mines in the Indian Bureau of Mines or any other authorised official of the Indian Bureau of Mines, returns in respect of each mine, in the following manner, namely:-</p> <p>(a) a monthly return which shall be submitted before the 10th of every month in respect of preceding month in the Form as indicated below:- (viii) for all other minerals in Form F-8;</p> <p>(b) an annual return which shall be submitted before the 1st July each year for the preceding financial year in the Form as indicated below:- (viii) for all other minerals in Form H-8:</p> <p>You have neither submitted the Monthly returns nor Annual returns ever since the opening of mine</p>

02. It is brought to your notice that the above said violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule-58 of MCDR, 1988. Besides, inability to comply the provision of Rule 13(1), 45(1) & (2), 45(5) (a)(viii) and 45(5)(b)(viii) are also liable for suspension of mining operations under rule 13(2) & 45(7)(i)(a) of MCDR, 1988.

03. You are, therefore, directed to show-cause within a period of 30(thirty) days from the date of issue of this letter, as to why you should not be prosecuted for the above offence and or Mining operations shall be suspended under the provision of Rule 13(2) & 45(7)(i)(a) of MCDR, 1988 in the Mine till the compliance of the aforesaid violation.
