i) Exploration: No exploration during year 2012-13 and 5 trial pits with depth 2.5 m each during 2013-14 were proposed in the approved Scheme of mining. The lessee had made 3 trails pits as on date on inspection (Upto Nov-13). In the lease area, the trend and occurrence of deposit could easily be assessed from exposure in the existing pit as there is no OB exists.

<u>ii) Workings</u>: During inspection, it was observed that the there is no deviation in site of working and dimension of existing pit is 50m X 20 m X 1.5m. Mining is being carried manually with pickaxes & crowbars. There is no OB and no drilling & blasting required.
