Sub:- Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 2017 in respect of your Govari Limestone Mine, over an extent of 558.90Ha. Situated in Govari-village, Teh-Wani, Yavatmal District of Maharashtra State.

Sir,

The following provision of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 2017 were found violated in your above mine during the inspection on 08/02/2021, by Shri Kalmata.M.K, Regional Mining Geologist, in presence of Shri .Suresh Madhukar Wandhare., Mines Manager & GM.

Rule	Nature of Violation observed
45 (7)	Following deficiencies were observed in the annual returns submitted for the year 2019-
	a) As per the monthly returns submitted for April-2019 to March-2020, ex-mine price of cement grade ore is shown as Rs-280.95/tonnes, but in the annual returns same is mentioned as Rs-290/tonnee. b) Value of fixed assets which is shown as 817.15 crore is appears huge and net closing balance shown for 2018-19 and value shown at the beginning of the year 2019-20 are not matching. Further in the annual returns of Govari mine, submitted for the year 2019-20, it is mentioned that under item 1 of part II-A, information on capital structure is furnished as combined information. for both Govari and sindola mines in the annual returns of sindola mine. If information on capital structure is furnished as combined information for both the mines, in the annual returns of Sidola mines, then the details of capital structure should be shown as zero in the Govari mines returns. However, the same information is repeated in annual returns of Govari mines, which leads to double entry of the data which is already furnished in the annual returns of Sindola mines

- 02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violation constitutes an offence, punishable under Rule 62 of MCDR, 2017.
- 03. The mining operations can be suspended under Rule 11(2), if compliance of MCD Rules 2017 is not found satisfactory, or prosecution can be made, or both can be done.
- 04. You are advised to rectify the above violation immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Fourty five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
