Sub: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 2017 in respect of your Barsua Iron Ore Mines in Sundergarh District of Odisha State.

Sir,

The following provision of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 (hereinafter referred as MCDR, 2017) was found violated in your above said mine during inspection on **04/10/2018** by the undersigned and Sri Dilip Jain, Junior Mining Geologist, of this office. The said inspection was carried out accompanied by Sri B.K. Soren, Mines Manager of your mine.

Rule	Nature of Violation observed
11(1)	The Scheme of Mining for having proposal for the period from period 2015-16 to 2019-20 was approved on 04/09/2015. The three years period i.e. from 2015-16 to 2017-18 of proposed period has been passed due to closure of mining operation in lease area. It is observed that, during the current year 2018-19, the mining operations are being carried & confined to the location proposed for the year 2015-16 in the approved scheme of mining, which is a clear violation of rule 11(1) of MCDR, 2017.

2. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under rule 62 of MCDR, 2017. Besides, inability to comply the provision of rule 11(1) is also liable for suspension of mining operation under the provision of rule 11(2) of MCDR, 2017 respectively.

3. You are advised to rectify the above violation immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (forty-five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
