You are advised to correct the submitted Mining Plan including Progressive Mine Closure Plan as per deficiencies /discrepancies pointed in the enclosed annexure as scrutiny comments and submit 3 fair copies of the Mining Plan including Progressive Mine Closure Plan within 15 days from the date of issue of this letter after corrections in hard bound copies (no spiral binding). If the fair copies of Mining Plan including Progressive Mine Closure Plan will not be submitted within stipulated time, final action will be taken as per rule. Two CDs of the fair Mining Plan including Progressive Mine Closure Plan may also be submitted including text, plates and annexures. On receipt of additional comments from State government, it shall be communicated to you subsequently. In case if it is necessary to incorporate the additional information, the details of the same should be given along with page numbers.

You are further advised to prepare the fair copies carefully and ensure that it is correct in all respect. Preferably use of paper on both the side should be made. If again deficiencies are observed then final action will be taken by this office without returning the copies for correction. This issues with the approval of competent authority.

Scrutiny comments indicating deficiencies in respect of submitted Review and updation of Mining Plan with PMCP of Chakdura limestone mine of Mr. Mushtaq Muzaffar Anem (21.106 hect.) located near village Bathyan, Tehsil Pampore, district Pulwama of J&K State submitted under Rule 17(1) of MCR 2016 & 23 of MCDR 2017.

1. Village name mentioned on cover page and page 4 are conflicting. Similarly pin code mentioned on page 3 & 4 are conflicting.
2. Review of previous approved scheme of mining is not adequately addressed. It is to be addressed with facts and figures as per actuals including kml file and print.
3. On page 7, under item 3.3, deviation has been observed but nil deviation is indicated.
4. Certificate- How the dates be same that of consent date for lessee.
5. Lease boundary is overlapping with the adjacent lease area as per kml file. Khasra map is enclosed alongwith annexure 3 but the shape is not matching with kml file.
6. Name of lessee and address given on cover page is not matching as per lease deed.
7. Page 9, mine is under suspension since when is to be mentioned.
8. On page no 17 boreholes are proposed in non mineralized zone for quartzite. Proper justification be given for such proposals.
9. Reserves under UNFC code 111 have been assessed on page 20 to the tune of 597000 tonnes. The same has not been mentioned in the table on page 26.
10. Mineral blocked is not as per guidelines.
11. On page 26 reserves have been indicated under UNFC code 121 & 122. Basis of estimation has not been indicated any where.
12. Total resources mentioned under UNFC code 332 & 333 on page 26 are not matching with the resources estimated on page 22 to 25. Thus reserves and resources need to be reassessed.
13. How Reserves and resources have been drastically reduced compare to R&R indicated in the previously approved scheme of mining. No justification and basis is indicated.
14. Page 33- ROM should be in cum. On similar page production indicated is almost double wrt previously approved mining plan. Reason to be given.
15. Life of the mine needs to be recalculated in view of re estimation of reserves.
16. Under review chapter on page no. 8 plantation target not achieved, reason is not given.
17. On page no 33 at Table I. In-situ Tentative Excavation in m³ I year mentioned from Nov 2020-21 which is not correct.
18. Area under green belt/rehabilitated is mentioned. The location of rehabilitated area is to be given. It shall not be the virgin area.
19. Orientation of pit wrt conceptual mining plan is not given.
20. Plantation shall be done along the lease boundary especially indicating along the prominent wind direction.
21. Page 50- Use of mineral- Correct specification is not mentioned. Analysis report is also not enclosed.
22. Page 53-item g-Only to be given in case it is in ML area.
23. Page 54- Employment potential-Statutory man power as per MCDR 2017 to be given.
24. On page no 58 Table- 8.3 additional area required during plan period is mentioned 0.50 ha but in financial assurance table additional area required during plan period is considered 0.30 ha, which is contradictory.
25. Page 81- Item 1(area under mining)- it should be 0.50 hectares and total area under put to use should be 5.62 hectares.
26. Page- 82- Total amount for FA- Area should be 5.62 hectares instead of 5.42 hectares.
27. Details of BG shall be given at the time of final submission.

28. Year wise PMCP proposal is incorrect.
29. All proposals shall be made within ML only.

Plates

30. Reclamation plan is not in line with PMCP proposals.
31. Conceptual plan to be redrawn in light of re estimation of R&R/ mineable reserves.
32. One composite section shall also be given for all five years for proposed excavated area. The same has not been given on plate 9 as stated.
33. Except Environmental Plan, all other plans & sections should be restricted to mine lease area only. No proposal should be made outside the ML area.
34. Statutory boundary 7.5 mtr barrier not shown in Surface Plan.
35. Ultimate Pit Limit configuration is not shown in surface plan.
36. Forest land shown in the SGP is not shown correctly.
37. Conceptual plan is incorrect.
38. Financial assurance plan- Incorrect area is indicated under area put to use.
39. Geological section do not match with plan.
40. Ultimate Pit Limit not shown in conceptual plan.
41. Ultimate Pit Limit not shown in Reclamation Plan.
42. Financial assurance plan is incorrect, sum of existing broken area and additional broken area do not matched with the total broken area.
43. **General-** The mine is located on hill slope. Hence adequate proposals should be incorporated like controlled blasting techniques, erecting retaining walls, check dams, parapet walls to ensure safe and systematic mining for ensuing five years.
44. There are several typographical mistakes which require to be corrected.
45. All the annexures should be attested by qualified persons for their authenticity.
46. A CD / pen drive covering the entire document and plans should be enclosed at the time of final submission. Undertaking in this regard by the qualified person should be given that the CD contains the same text & plates as submitted in hard copy.
47. Additional comments shall also be communicated to you in case of receipt of comments from State government if any.

Note: All the corrections pointed out in the text and plates shall also be attended.
