विषय Sub: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 2017 in respect of your Barwas Limestone Mine, Mining Lease over an area of 4.157 ha located near Village-Barwas, Tehsil-Paonta Sahib in Sirmour district of HP State.

महोदय Sir,

The following provisions of the Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 2017 (MCDR,2017) were found violated in your above mine during the inspection made by the undersigned on 17-11-2019 in the presence of Shri Parvesh Kumar (Partner) and the same was communicated to you vide our letter of even number dated on 26-12-2019.

RULE NO.	NATURE OF VIOLATION OBSERVED
11(1)	Mining operations were not carried out in accordance with the approved modified mining plan vide letter no 614(2)/MP-B-247/14- DDN dated 01.02.2019 to the following extent: (i) As per proposals 2 DTH were to be drilled upto a depth of 20 mtrs each but during the inspection it was observed no such DTH drilling carried out during the year 2018-19. (ii) As per proposals mining shall be carried out by formation of three benches maintaining the bench height of 5 mtrs each. During the inspection, it was observed that the height of the benches has about 10 mtrs.
26(2)	The holder of mining lease shall submit to the competent authority a yearly report as per the format specified by the Indian Bureau of Mines, before 1 st day of July every year setting forth the extent of protective and rehabilitative works carried out as envisaged in the approved mine closure plan, and if there is any deviation, reasons thereof : On perusal of office records it is observed that yearly report for the year 2018-19 has not been submitted to the competent authority by the holder of the lease in the prescribed in this office till date.
28(1)	Mining Operations are discontinued from more than Ninety days but notice of temporary discontinuance has not been submitted to this office.
35(2)	Every holder of a mining lease shall monitor his mining and allied activities as per the notified template of star rating in the format prescribed in this behalf by the Indian Bureau of Mines from time to time, and shall submit online its self assessment report before the 1 st day of July every year for the previous financial year, along with the soft

	copy (in standard format), of high resolution satellite images obtained from CARTOSAT-2 satellite LISS-IV sensor on the scale of cadastral map, as on the 31 st day of march for that financial year, covering the mining lease and an area of two kilometers from the lease boundary, to the Regional Controller or the authorized of the Indian Bureau of Mines. Whereas holder of the mining lease has not submitted by the online self assessment report and the satellite images as per rules.
54	The holder of a mining lease shall maintain the royalty assessment register, where the same was not found maintained.
54(a)	The holder of a mining lease shall maintain Details of contribution made to District Mineral Foundation and National Mineral Exploration Trust, where the details was not found maintained

2. However, your letter No. nil dated 16-03-2020 received at this office on 19-03-2020 was examined and based on documents/details furnished compliance of the rules 28(1) has been considered, whereas for remaining rules i.e. for rules 11(1), 26(2), 35(2), 54 & 54(a) no satisfactory reply and documents has been furnished thus the compliance is not found observed. Thus the violation of rules 11(1), 26(2), 35(2), 54 & 54(a) of MCDR, 2017 still persists.
3. In this connection, it is brought to your kind notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of MCDR 2017.
4. Mining operations can be suspended as per rule 11(2) in case of non compliance of rule 11(1) of MCDR, 2017.
5. May initiate appropriate action in accordance with any competent orders/directives etc.
6. You are therefore directed to show cause within a period of thirty (30) days from the date of issue of this letter, as to why you should not be prosecuted and / or why mining operation can be suspended under statutory provisions.
7. Please note that no further notice will be given to you in this regards.
