विषय Sub: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 2017 in respect of your Bhimgoda Limestone Mine, Mining Lease over an area of 3.05 ha located near Village-Kamroo, Tehsil-Karmoo in Sirmour district of HP State.

महोदय Sir,


The following provisions of the Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 2017 were found violated in your above mine during the inspection made by the undersigned on 23.01.2020 in the presence of Shri Shom Prakash Tomar Mine Manager and the same was communicated to you vide our letter of even number dated on 18.02.2020

<u>RULE NO.</u>	<u>NATURE OF VIOLATION OBSERVED</u>
11(1)	Mining operation were not carried out in accordance with the approved modified mining plan vide letter no 614(2)/MS-B-65/98-DDN dated 04.06.2018 to the following extent: (i) As per proposal during the year 2018-19, it was proposed to carry out 03 DTH bore holes total meterage 113 mtr, but during the inspection it was observed no such DTH drilling carried out during the year 2018-19. (ii) As per proposal during the year 2018-19, it was proposed to carry out mining operation from 1929 to 1905 marl by formation of 4 benches with 6 mtr height. During the inspection height of benches has been observed about 10 mtrs whereas as per approved modified mining plan it should be six meter.
26(2)	The holder of mining lease shall submit to the competent authority a yearly report as per the format specified by the Indian Bureau of Mines, before 1 st day of July every year setting forth the extent of protective and rehabilitative works carried out as envisaged in the approved mine closure plan, and if there is any deviation, reasons thereof : On perusal of office records it is observed that yearly report for the year 2018-19 has not been submitted to the competent authority by the holder of the lease in the prescribed in this office till date.
33	The holder of a mining lease shall, on or before the 30 th day of June every year submit to the authorized officer a digital copy along with a print copy of the surface geological plans and sections maintained under rule 32. However, the lessee has not submitted the copies of the plans and sections as per rules for the year 2018-19
45(5)(c)	Annual returns for the years ending 31 st March 2018 and 31 st March 2017 have not been submitted by the lessee to the Regional controller/authorized officer of Indian Bureau of Mines.

However, your letter No. nil dated 13-03-2020 received at this office on 20-03-2020 was examined and based on documents/details furnished compliance of the none of the violated rules has not been observed ,as no documents has been furnished thus the compliance is not found observed. Hence the violation of rules 11(1), 26(2), 33 & 45(5)(c) of MCDR, 2017 still persists.
3. In this connection, it is brought to your kind notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of MCDR 2017.
4. Mining operations can be suspended as per rule 11(2) in case of non compliance of rule 11(1) of MCDR, 2017.
5. May Advise the State Government to order suspension of all mining operation in the mine as per provision of Rule 45(7), in case incomplete or wrong or false information has been furnished in statutory returns or fails to submit statutory returns under rule 45.
6. May initiate appropriate action in accordance with any competent orders/directives etc.
7. You are therefore directed to show cause within a period of thirty (30) days from the date of issue of this letter, as to why you should not be prosecuted and / or why mining operation can be suspended under statutory provisions.
8. Please note that no further notice will be given to you in this regards.
