Subject: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017, in respect of your Mawlong limestone mine over an area of 4.56 Ha. in East Khasi Hills district of Meghalaya.

Sir,

Undersigned has issued violation letter of even number dated 14.11.17 for below mentioned rules of Mineral Conservation & Development Rules, 2017.

Rule Number	Nature of violations observed
11(3) Every approved mining plan shall be subjected to review & updation in every five years as per the provision of sub rule 1 of rule 17 of Minerals (Other than Atomic & Hydrocarbon Energy Minerals) Concession Rules 2016.	After approval of the mining plan on 5.5.2005 for fresh grant of ML, no document has been submitted to this office regarding review & updation of the mining plan for the next five years & further onwards.
27(2): Where financial assurance is required to be furnished by the holder of the mining lease under sub-rule (1), such amount of financial assurance shall be submitted to the authorised officer, as the case may be, in the form of a bank guarantee in the format specified by the Indian Bureau of Mines:	guarantee has been submitted to this office til date.

- 02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017.
- 03. The mining operations can be suspended under rule 11(2), if compliance of rule 11(1) is not found satisfactory.
- 04. You are, therefore, directed to show cause within a period of 30 days from the date of issue of this letter, as to why you should not be prosecuted for the above offences.
- 05. Please note that no further notice will be given to you in this regard
