Subject: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017, in respect of your Umrangshu limestone mine over an extent of 31.00 Ha. in Dima Hasao district of Assam State.

Sir,

On perusal of the office records, the following provisions of MCDR, 2017 were found violated in your above mine.

Rule Number	Nature of violations observed
11(3): Every approved mining plan shall be subjected to review & updation in every five years as per the provision of sub rule 1 of rule 17 of Minerals (Other than Atomic & Hydrocarbon Energy Minerals) Concession Rules 2016.	After approval of the last review of mining plan vide letter dated 27.5.2003, no document has been submitted to this office regarding review & up-dation of the mining plan for the next five years & further onwards. After issue of violation cum show cause notice from this office, the draft review of mining plan was submitted on 13.3.2018. The submitted draft was perused & not approved vide letter dated 23.4.2018 from this office, due to a number of deficiencies in the submitted document. Till date no draft review of mining plan has been re-submitted to this office for its perusal.


02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017.

03. The mining operations can be suspended under rule 11(2), if compliance of rule 11(1) is not found satisfactory.

04. You are, therefore, directed to show cause within a period of 30 days from the date of issue of this letter, as to why you should not be prosecuted for the above offences.


