Sub: Violation in respect of Yanakandla limestone mine of Sree Jayajyothi Cements Pvt.Ltd. over an extent of 343.22 ha. in yanakandla, Pathapadu, Meerapuram Village banganapalli Mandal, Kurnool district, Andhra Pradesh Submitted under rule 17(3) of MCR, 2016.

Sir,

The following provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules 2017 (MCDR, 2017), were found violated in your above mine based on mine inspection by the undersigned on 25/11/2019. Shri JayaBharata Reddy and your other representatives were present during the inspection.

Rule No	Rule Position
45(7)(a)	<p>If it is found that the holder of a mining lease or the person or company engaged in trading or storage or end-use or export of minerals, as the case may be, has submitted incomplete or wrong or false information in daily or monthly or annual returns or fails to submit a return within the date specified; then,— (a) in the case of mining of minerals by the holder of a mining lease, the Regional Controller of Mines may advise the State Government to,— (i) order suspension of all mining operations in the mine and to revoke the order of suspension only after ensuring proper compliance; (ii) take action to initiate prosecution under these rules; (iii) recommend termination of the mining lease, in case such suppression or misrepresentation of information indicates abetment or connivance of illegal mining;</p> <p>However during inspection it has been noted that the ex mine price and the cost of production has been submitted as Rs 324 Per MT which is prima facie on a higher side. Depreciation figure too is not corresponding with the figures in Part –II A. The data needs to be substantiated with the document.</p>
11(1)	<p>No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines.</p> <p>However, against the proposal of 500 saplings over 0.6 hectare area you have not carried out plantation as per proposal. Only 250 saplings have been planted in 2018-19 as a replacement for the plants which have not survived.</p>
67	<p>The labour attendance register and summary of the performance of the machinery used be produced for the year 2018-19 for sample check of the information furnished in the annual return.</p>

02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under rule 62 of MCDR, 2017. Further, inability to comply the provision of Rule 45(7)(a) and 11(1) is liable for suspension of mining operations under 11(2) and 45(7)(a) of MCDR,2017.

03. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
