Sub: Violation of provisions of MCDR, 2017 in respect of Sitapuram Limestone Mine-I over an area of 770.23 ha in Dondapadu Village, Suryapet District, Telangana State.

Sir,

The following provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 were found violated in your above mine during the inspection on 18.12.2019 by the undersigned accompanied by Sri N.Hariprasad, DGM(Mines).

Rule No.	Nature of Violation
11(1)	No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government pursuant to the proviso to clause (b) of sub-section (2) of section 5.
	Mining operations are not being carried out in accordance with the proposals given in the Review of Mining Plan approved vide letter no. AP/NLG/MP/LST-52/HYD dated 09.12.2016 to the extent indicated below:
	"There was no proposal for generation and utilization of Topsoil during the year 2018-19. However, it was reported that 1000 Cu.M of Topsoil was produced during the year 2018-19."
33	The holder of a mining lease shall, on or before the 30th day of June every year submit to the authorised officer, as the case may be, and the State Government, a digital copy along with a print copy of the surface geological plans and sections maintained under rule 32.
	"The same have not been submitted to this office till date".
40	Every holder of prospecting licence or a mining lease shall take all possible measure to keep air pollution due to fines, dust, smoke or gaseous emissions during prospecting, mining, beneficiation or metallurgical operations and related activities within permissible limits.
	"During the inspection of the Mines it was observed that no measures for dust suppression were undertaken"

02. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above said violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule-62 of MCDR, 2017.

O3. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (forty five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
