The following provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 1988 (amended up to 2011) were found violated during inspection of the above mine on 20.9.2016 by undersigned accompanied by Sri.K.K.Jha, Agent(Mine)

13(1)	Mining operations should have been undertaken in accordance with the approved Mining

	The Mining Plan was approved vide letter no.KNK/FE/MPLN-1151/NGP dated
	03.07.2015 and following deviation was observed during inspection
	1. It was proposed to drill 21 nos of core drill holes in 2015-16 but only 18 core holes
	drilled and also for 2016-17 30 nos core drill holes of 100 meter depth each proposed
	but till date no drilling started not yet given any intimation of drilling in form-j.
	2. The dumping for 2015-16 was proposed near the western lease boundary but actually
	the dumping is done near northern lease boundary.
45(5)(b)(i)	An annual return which shall be submitted before 1 st of july each year for the preceding
	financial year in H1. But during the scrutiny of H1 for 2015-16 it was observed that the
	name of Mining Engineer is mentioned Mr. Ram lakhan thakur and Geologist Mr.
	Roopsai Taigor whereas as per Notice of appointment submitted in Form-I dated
	08.09.2016 the name given for Mining Engineer is Mr.shailendra kumar suryavanshi and
	Geologist Mr.Ghanshyam Prasad Namdeo.

- 02. It is brought to your notice that the above said violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule-58 of MCDR, 1988. Besides, inability to comply the provision of Rule 13(1) & Rule 45(5) (b)(i) attracts provisions of Rule 13(2) & 45(7)(i)(a) which are liable for suspension of mining operations under rule 13(2) of MCDR, 1988.
- O3. You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (forty five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
