Sub.: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017, in respect of your Piprahat limestone mine, 38MPR35275, Area 8.068 hectare, in District Satna of MP.

Sir.

Following provisions of MCDR 2017 were found violated in your above mine during the inspection by the Undersigned on 08.03.2021 in the presence of Shri.K.N.Ojha (Mines Head) and Shri Lalji Tiwary (Mines Manager).

Rule No	Nature of violation observed in detail
11(1)	No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government.
	 In the year 2019-20 it was proposed to drill 4 core boreholes at a grid interval 100m for a total depth of 200 meter. However, it is observed that proposed boreholes were not carried out during the said year. In the year 2019-20 it was proposed to produce 154312 MT of limestone but only 67300 MT production achieved against the same.
26(2)	The holder of mining lease shall submit to the competent authority a yearly report as per the format specified by the Indian Bureau of Mines, before 1stday of July every year setting forth the extent of protective and rehabilitative works carried out as envisaged in the approved mine closure plan, and if there is any deviation, reasons thereof: During scrutiny of the office records, it has been observed that the yearly report in respect of rule 26(2) of MCDR 2017 has not been submitted for the year 2019-20.

- 1. In this connection, it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of Mineral Conservations and Development Rules, 2017.
- 2. The mining operations can be suspended under the rule 11(2) of MCDR-2017, if compliance of rule 11(1) of MCDR-2017 is not found satisfactory.
- 3. You are advised to rectify the violations of abovementioned rules immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty-Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
