Vikram Cement Limestone Mines (VCLM-III) (area-546.106 Hect.) in District of **Neemuch** in
M.P.State.

Dear Sir,

The following provisions of the Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 were found violated in your above mentioned mine during MCDR inspection on 22.01.2021 by the undersigned in presence of Shree Manish Dixit ,GM geology and Shree Akhilesh Singh, Mines Head.

Rule 11(1) MCDR 2017	<p>1. Mining operations under mining lease.-(1) No holder of a mining lease shall commence or carry out mining operations in any area except in accordance with the mining plan approved, modified or reviewed by the Indian Bureau of Mines or prepared and certified in accordance with the system established by the State Government pursuant to the proviso to clause (b) of sub-section (2) of section 5 or approved by the competent authority of the Atomic Minerals Directorate for Exploration and Research, in respect of minerals specified in Part B of the First Schedule to the Act where the grade of such atomic minerals is equal to or above the threshold value limits declared under Schedule-A of the Atomic Minerals Concession Rules, 2016.</p> <p>(2) If the mining operations are not carried out in accordance with the approved or certified mining plan or any information contained in the mining plan is found to be incorrect, misleading or non-compliant with applicable laws including these rules, the competent authority may by order, suspend all or any of the mining operations and permit continuance of only such operations as are required to restore the conditions in the mine as envisaged under the approved or certified mining plan or modified mining plan, for the purpose of restoration to the extent possible :</p> <p>During Inspection It is observed:</p> <p>(1) The production of limestone is very less, only 2200T against proposal of 1,00,000 T and no other activities viz development (OB Removal). Top soil usage have been carried out in mines as per approved mining plan in during 2019-20. (planned OB-5000T, topsoil-1300M3)</p> <p>(2) 31 exploratory boreholes have not been done against the proposal.</p> <p>(3) Plantation of 1000 nos is not done (660 nos. approx done.) and survival rate for same is poor less than 50%.</p> <p>Thus there is violation of this rule .</p>

03 .You are advised to rectify the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.


