Sub: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 in respect of your Kodla Limestone Mine (ML No. 2673/2674) over an area of 517.61 Ha located in Kodla & Benkanhalli Villages, Sedam taluk, Kalaburgi Dist., Karnataka State

Sir,

The following provisions of the Mineral Conservation & Development Rules 2017 were found violated in your above mine during the inspection carried out by the undersigned in presence of Shri. Kiran Naidu, Manager Mining and Shri. GNS Rangarao, Geologist on 15.12.2018.

<b>Rule</b>	<b>Nature of violations observed</b>
11(1)	<p>Mining Plan with PMCP was approved vide letter No.279/1043/2009/BNG/2171 dt 17.11.2017 for a period of five years The deviation observed in mining operation vis-a-vis approved document are given below:</p> <p>i) The production &amp; development was proposed in between section lines S5 to S9 &amp; E5 to E9, where as it was observed that the same was started from S5 to S7 &amp; E5 to E9, thus deviation from the approved mining plan.</p> <p>ii) It was also observed that the location of the OB dump was proposed towards the western part of the ML area in between section lines S5 to S7, where as OB was dumped in S1to S3.</p>

02. In this connection it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of MCDR 2017. Further, the violation of Rule 11(1) may also attract provisions of Rule 11(2) of MCDR, 2017 regarding suspension of mining operations till the compliance of violations.

03. You are advised to rectify/explain the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
