Sub: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 in respect of your Dharmapur Iron Ore Mines, ML.No.2239, (43.58Ha) located in Sandur Taluk, Ballari district, Karnataka state.

Sir,

The following provisions of the Mineral Conservation & Development Rules 2017 were found violated in your above mine during the inspection carried out by the undersigned in presence of Shri. A. Gururaj , Mines manager , Shri B. Lohith Kumar D R ,Geologist and Shri.C. T. Varaprasad , Mining Engineer on 13.11.2018.

Rule	Nature of violations observed
11(1)	As per the approved document vide letter No.279/69/89/BNG/1224 dt 02.07.2018, workings was proposed in cross section A2-A2' to H-H' towards north west & south west direction. It was observed that no working has been carried out in between the section lines E-E' to H-H' towards north west.
19(1)	Where heavy earth moving machinery is used in mines, the holder of a mining lease shall maintain log books duly authenticated by the manager or mining engineer of such mines in respect of each machine showing date-wise account of hours worked, hours not worked, reasons for non-working, consumption of fuel or energy and lubricants and output of the machine during the corresponding working hours. The log books of HEMM used in the mines was not maintained

02. In this connection it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of MCDR 2017.Further, the violation of Rule

11(1) may also attract provisions of Rule 11(2) of MCDR, 2017 regarding suspension of mining operations till the compliance of violations.

03. You are advised to rectify/explain the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
