Sub: Violation of provisions of Mineral Conservation and Development Rules, 2017 in respect of your Narayanapura Manganese & Iron Ore Mine, ML No. 1602 over an area of 107.51 Ha. Located in Narayanapura village, Sandur Taluk, Ballari District of Karnataka State

Sir,

The following provisions of the Mineral Conservation & Development Rules 2017 were found violated in your above mine during the inspection carried out by the undersigned in presence of Shri. V.Lowa Raju, Manager Mining and Dr. Venkata Subbaiah, Geologist on 15.11.2018.

<b>Rule</b>	<b>Nature of violations observed</b>
11(1)	As per the approved document vide letter No.279/138/89/BNG/1355 dt. 17.07.2018, twelve (12) nos. of boreholes with total meterage of 590 mts of exploration was proposed in the year 2018-19. It was observed that Exploration proposal for the year 2018-19 was not yet started.
46(c)	<b>Notice of certain appointments</b> - The holder of the prospecting licence or prospecting license cum mining lease or the mining lease shall,- when any change occurs in the address of any such person, within fifteen days from the date of such appointment, termination, leaving or change in address, give a notice in Form H of the Schedule to the authorised officer, as the case may be. The notice of appointment of Mining Engineer has not been sent to this office.

02. In this connection it is brought to your notice that the above violations constitute an offence punishable under Rule 62 of MCDR 2017. Further, the violation of Rule 11(1) may also attract provisions of Rule 11(2) of MCDR, 2017 regarding suspension of mining operations till the compliance of violations.

03. You are advised to rectify/explain the above violations immediately and intimate the position to this office within 45 (Forty Five) days from the date of issue of this letter.
